Among these are the Step Pyramid of Djoser, the Pyramid of Unas, which contains some of the earliest known funerary texts, the Tomb of Idut (Idu) located in the section of the Pyramid of Unas, the Pyramid of

Teti, the tomb of Mereruka, and the Serapeum of Saqqara. In addition, the Emu Hotob Museum contains a wealth of information about Egyptian art and culture.

At the end of the tour, you will be transferred back to the port of Alexandria.
