Our professional representative will be waiting for you at the Sokhna Port upon your arrival to commence the [tour of the Giza pyramids](#) by visiting the three magnificent Pyramids that started the idea of building this wonderful monument, [Cheops](#) which is the largest required and an astounding 2,300,000 blocks, weighing a hefty 2.5 tons each.

The pyramid of King Chephren, the successor of his father and the founder of the second pyramid, is nevertheless taller and has more inclined faces than the other pyramids at Giza. This gives the impression of being the largest of the pyramids at Giza, and the pyramid of King [Mycerinus](#), where his name was discovered in red ochre on the ceiling of the burial chamber, is one of the subsidiary pyramids as well. Through inscribed artifacts found in the area, it is clear that sculptors were of a high degree of intelligence. You will also see the great [Sphinx](#), with the head of a man and the body of a lion, as well as the [Valley Temple](#) dedicated for the Mummification of the Pharaoh's body.

If you'd like to enjoy the view and the vibes of the Nile for about 1 hour with a Felucca ride , we can include a one-hour sailing experience through the Nile. It'll be a fun way to spend a relaxing day, and we'll make sure that you have a great time.

The Nile River is an important part of Egyptian culture and history. It is an icon of life, and was a religious place for the ancient Egyptians. They believed that all their gods came from the Nile, and they made offerings to it for having a long life or an increase in their crops.
