1- Egyptian Pyramids in Giza

The Giza pyramids, built 2500 years ago, are a reminder of the ancient Egyptian dynasty that produced some of history's most influential leaders. The third dynasty was responsible for the construction of the Giza pyramids, which are now the tombs of many [Kings and Rulers of Egypt](#).

As part of your tour of the pyramids, you'll see The imposing [Sphinx](#) which features the body of a lion and the head of a monarch wearing a turban. Some scientists believed it to be [the son of the sun deity \(Ra\)](#), the Sphinx standing for strength, intelligence, and the long-lasting life of Egypt. Next, go to complete your tour of the Giza plateau by going to The Great Sphinx and its related temple is right adjacent to the Valley Temple, which serves as a gateway to the entire complex.
