and the rituals of worship were specific to the gods called (Ptah).

then continue to visit the area of Dahshor which is Located about 40 kilometers southwest of Cairo, the village of Dahshur marks the southern end of the vast pyramid field that begins at Giza.

then end your day with an amazing time sailing through the Nile during a Felucca ride.

then you will be transferred to your ship in Sokhna Port.
