Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Day

Our tour leader will meet you at <u>Cairo Airport</u> and then transfer you to your hotel in a modern, airconditioned vehicle. Upon arrival, you will be assisted with a smooth check-in.

believe they should be conserved for future generations.
