Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

When you arrive at our Cairo hotel, our tour leader will help you with the procedures. After you've collected your luggage, he'll take you in our luxurious vehicle to your Four Seasons or Nile Kempinski hotel for the night.

Day 2: Pyramids, Saqqara, Dahshour

After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, you will be transferred to the <u>Necropolis of Giza</u>, where you will see the three pyramids of ancient kings, Cheops, Khafre, and Mikrenius, as well as the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, This is the most famous monument not only of ancient Egypt but of the entire ancient world.

If you visit <u>Saqqara</u> and the Step Pyramid of Djoser with him, you'll get to see some of the most amazing tombs in Egypt. You'll also get a chance to see the mastaba of Kagemni, one of the most important tombs from ancient times.

Then visit Dashur, where you can see the two pyramids built by Pharaoh Sneferu. Not only can you see the Red Pyramid, the first real pyramid in the world, but you also have the chance to go inside it.

then have your lunch at a local restaurant and get back to your hotel.

Day 3: the Egyptian Museum, NMEC Museum

We'll have breakfast at the hotel in Cairo before going to the Egyptian Museum, Your professional guide will take you on a fascinating tour of the museum's impressive collection of Egyptian antiquities, including the golden treasures of the famous pharaoh Tutankhamun.

Then he will take you to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization to see an incredible collection of 50,000 artifacts illustrating Egyptian civilization from prehistoric times to the present day.

Day 4: the Citadel, Old Cairo

After breakfast, you will be driven to the Saladin Citadel, a fortress that was built between 1176 and 1183 AD to defend Cairo from the Crusaders and rebuilt by Muhammad Ali Pasha, whose mosque is a must-see.

After enjoying a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, you'll be able to explore some of Cairo's most famous churches: the Hanging Church and the Church of St. George the Martyr, both built into the walls of the ancient Fort of Babylon. The Church of Abu Serga (St. Sergius), where it is said the Holy Family took shelter in a cave, is also on the tour. And the remains of Cairo's oldest structure, the Fort of Babylon, could be its oldest structure.

This is a great place for tourists to visit. It's a popular tourist destination, and at the end of the day, you'll be driven to the old market of Cairo (Khan El-Khalili) to see how good your bargaining skills are.

The Alexandria National Museum houses an impressive collection of artifacts that tell the story of Alexandria. Recent finds from the sunken part of the city have been added to the collection, deepening the museum's already rich history.

The <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u> is one of the most important historical sites in the Mediterranean region. It was originally built by the Mameluke Sultan Al-Ashraf Qaitbay in 1480 AD and has since undergone many improvements. Today, it is a highly visible and important citadel on the coastline.

We'll have a delicious lunch at a local restaurant in Al-Morsi Abu EL-Abbas, and then you'll be able to relax and drive back to your hotel in Alexandria (Hilton Alexandria) at the end of the day.

Day 6: AL-Alamien, Return to Cairo

It has a collection of more than 30,000 artifacts, including weapons, uniforms, and other items used by soldiers during the war. After touring the magnificent statues of Amenhotep III, known as the Colossi of Memnon, you'll be able to return home aboard your ship, making your way to the beautiful city of Edfu.

Continue your early-morning sightseeing tour of Aswan while having dinner back on board.

Day 10: Aswan Sightseeing, travel to Hurghada

Starting your day on a Nile cruise ship will give you a unique perspective on the city of Aswan, which was important during ancient Egyptian history. You can then spend the rest of the day touring some of the most famous highlights in the city.
