Itinerary

Day 01: arrival in Cairo

An English-speaking representative will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, help you with any processes, and take you to your hotel so you can rest for the evening.

Day 02: Visit the Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum

We'll pick you up in the hotel lobby in the morning and drive you to your first location the following day. One of the most significant collections of Egyptian art in the world is found at the Egyptian Museum in Cairo.

Priceless relics abound, such as a collection of jewelry, gold, and diamonds that belonged to Pharaoh Tutankhamun and were preserved in his tomb for over three millennia. Why not have a delectable meal at one of our local eateries after lunch?

One of the most striking and well-known tourist attractions in Egypt, The <u>Great Sphinx</u>, will be your next stop after seeing the three tallest pyramids at Giza. The enormous Sphinx holds the skeletal remains of a monarch and his queen.

Day 03: Alexandria day tour

Our knowledgeable tour guide will pick you up at your Cairo hotel after breakfast and take you on an amazing tour of Alexandria. One of the most significant libraries in antiquity, "The Alexandria Library," is where you will start your tour of Alexandria.

Following your tour of Alexandria's historical sights, you will be transported to a neighboring restaurant for lunch. You will resume your tour of Pompey's Column and the Roman Amphitheater after lunch. Among the most well-known sites from the Greco-Roman era is this one.

We will take you on a delightful day excursion to view the <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, one of Alexandria's most well-known landmarks, from the outside. Once your day excursion is done, we will return you to Cairo for the night.

After arriving in Cairo, you'll have a chance to spend the night at your hotel.

Day 04: Day Tour to Luxor by Air

Your hotel will provide a breakfast box before you are transported to the Cairo airport, where our private tour guide will meet you to begin your spectacular tour of Thebes, the sacred region. Upon arrival at the Luxor airport, our tour guide will take you to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, considered to be the royal cemetery of the Theban kings and rulers of ancient Egypt.

Next, you will visit the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut in Deir El Bahari</u>. This beautiful temple is carved entirely into the mountain, making it one of the most impressive examples of ancient Egyptian architecture. You will then visit the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which was owned by King Amenhotep III. These three sites will make for a truly memorable visit.

After lunch, you'll visit the <u>East Bank tour of Luxor</u>, home to the magnificent <u>Karnak Temple</u> Complex. This magnificent site is considered to be the biggest construction project in the world. Finally, you'll visit the Temple of Luxor, built by one of the great kings of the 12th dynasty and completed by the famous king Ramses II.

In the evening, you will be driven to Luxor airport and fly back to Cairo.
