Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo during Easter

Your English-speaking tour leader from Cairo Top Tours is going to meet and assist you at <u>Cairo</u> International Airport and then he will escort you to the hotel by exclusive air-conditioned deluxe vehicle.

Upon arrival at the hotel, you will be served a welcome drink while our representative assist you with a smooth check-in and review your trip itinerary with you to confirm pick-up time for each tour during your Cairo Short Break During the Easter tour.

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sakkara Tour

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel in Cairo and after that you will meet your tour guide to start your breath-taking Cairo Day Tours.

You'll be visiting the Great Pyramid of Cheops, one of the three pyramids at Giza, which was completed nearly 2560 BCE. It is one of the largest and most impressive pyramids, in addition to the Pyramids of Chefren and Mykerinus and their protector the Great Sphinx.

Then you will go to <u>Saqqara</u> to visit the Step Pyramid Complex constructed by the famous architect Imhotep of king Djoser, it is considered the oldest building in the world made out of stone. You will also visit <u>the pyramid of Teti</u> inside and the tombs of the nobles at <u>Sakkara</u> to gain a glimpse of daily life in ancient Egypt with all its activities engraved and painted on the walls and corridors of those 4000 years old tombs.

Stopping for a lunch in a nice local restaurant. After that we will move to <u>Memphis</u> to visit the open-air museum.

You will be transferred back to your hotel to spend the night there.

Day 3: Cairo Tours

Begin your Egypt Day Tours as usual with a breakfast at the hotel in <u>Cairo</u>. You will be accompanied by your Egyptologist tour guide to visit <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>, where the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities is located all over the world. Additionally, the only royal treasure found intact is the Treasures of the golden <u>Tutankhamen</u>.

Then your personal guide and driver will take you to see the Citadel of Saladin where you can see Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque inside, and get a panoramic view of Islamic Cairo with mosques, minarets, and domes hundreds of years old and some above one thousand years old.

The tour continues to Coptic Cairo to visit the <u>Roman fortress of Babylon</u>, <u>the Hanging Church</u> and <u>the church of St Sergius</u>, we will aslo visit <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u> said to be the site of the pharaoh's palace where the basket of Moses was picked up from the Nile.

After Lunch, you will be heading to enjoy <u>Islamic Cairo</u>, exploring the walls and gates of this medieval city and its old streets dating back to the 10th century the walk end with tea at Fishawy, one of the famous and

historic cafes located in Khan El Khalili, Cairo's old bazaar.

Back to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.
