Itinerary

Day 1 - Cairo to the white desert

in the morning our tour leader waits for you in your hotel in Cairo and then picks you up in the white desert in a modern, air-conditioned luxury vehicle. Travel to Bahariya Oasis, 350 kilometers western desert of Cairo, During the flight, there will be two coffee breaks. It is useless for tourists because Wahat Bahariya is the main supplier of iron ore in Egypt, When you get to Baharyia Oasis, you'll meet your safari guide, get in your 4x4 Jeep, and begin your trip. First, we will visit the black desert Its mountains, highlands, and dunes are all covered in a thin layer of black powder, which is why the name. Some mountains' peaks are covered in this powder. next, we will transfer to El Haize oasis which is located 37 km from Bawiti where you can have lunch after that you can enjoy swimming in a hot water spring which feels calm and comfortable. next, we will visit the Valley of Agabat is a beautiful place to visit. It is a place where you can experience the beauty of nature and the history of the people who have lived in the area for centuries. and covered with white sand was created as a result of sandstorms, finally, Finally, you can relax in your tent and enjoy the view of sunset in the desert, golden sands, and dinner.

Day 2 - djara cave, the Ain El-Serw Spring

In the morning you can see the Sunrise from the desert, then you can have breakfast, after that we will drive to The Djara Cave is One of the most stunning pre-historic locations in the western desert, Djara Cave, breaks up the still and ethereal desert with its bedrock structures defying gravity. The cave has the only perfectly intact rock art images of gazelles and other wild animals within a 250 km radius. The enchanting beauty of this location is further enhanced by the dripstone roof of the cave, which was created by crystal depositions over millions of years. The White Desert, also known as El Farafra Oasis, is a serene and ethereal desert. next, we will visit the Ain El-Sera Spring which is a popular spring in Egypt that is known for its therapeutic and healing properties. The spring is located in the El-Gabal district of the Cairo Governorate. Ain El-Sera has been used by Egyptians for centuries as a place to heal and relax. The spring is known for its high mineral content, which is said to be beneficial for health. Spring is also said to have a calming effect on the mind and body. Visitors to Ain El-Serw can enjoy the spring water, which is said to be very clean and refreshing. The spring is also a popular spot for picnics and other outdoor activities, then you have lunch in the desert of Sera and enjoy of view of the desert, till sunset and see the most beautiful view of stars and moon and have dinner in your camp.

Day 3 - explore, bahariya oasis

In the morning after having breakfast, we will drive to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, You will stop at Crystal Mountain, sometimes referred to as Jabal Al-Azzaz locally, on the way back. It is more of a <u>crystalline mound</u>, as shown to the right, that is made up of quartzite crystals and is referred to as the jewel of the desert. It also appears stunning in the sunlight. This natural feature was discovered by accident a few decades ago. next drive to Bahariya oasis which is one of the most beautiful and secluded places on earth. Tucked away in the western desert of Egypt, this oasis is a hidden gem known only to a select few. Bahariya Oasis is a place of natural beauty and serenity. The landscape is filled with palm trees, date palms, and acacia trees, and the air is filled with the scent of jasmine and orange blossoms. The oasis is home to a variety of wildlife, including deer, ibex, and oryx. then we will drive to your hotel and check in then have lunch after that we will start our trip to discover the Bahariya oasis. You will find Gebel Maghrafa, the palm and olive farms, and Bahariya Oasis. There, in 1914, at the foot of Gebel Dist, the largest Diansour ((Stromer's Tidal Giant)) ever found, was found. The largest salt lake in Bahariya Oasis is Lake al-Marun. Enjoy the sunset from the English Mountain's summit (Gebel Al Ingleez). A panoramic of the northern portion of the oasis is seen from the top.

at last, we will return to the hotel.

Day 4 -Baharyia oasis- Cairo

after having breakfast we will transfer to Bawiti which is the capital of Bahariya Oasis, an oasis in the Western Desert of Egypt. The oasis is about 350 km (217 mi) away from Cairo. The Bahariya Oasis is the largest oasis in the Western Desert. It is also one of the most populous oases in the Western Desert, with a population of around 30,000 people. After that, go to the Ain El Muftella shrine and the Museum of the Golden Mummies in Bahariya Oasis. After lunch there, drive to Cairo.
