Itinerary

day 1: Luxor attractions, (Luxor temple, Karnak temple)

On your first day of the MS Moon dance ship Nile cruise tour from Luxor to Aswan, you will meet our professional tour leader holding the <u>Cairo top tours</u> sign at <u>Luxor international airport</u>, then you will be taken to the gorgeous MS Hapi 5 Nile cruise and visit:

Luxor temple:

Booths of Thutmose III. These booths are presented by four graceful pillars in the form of a bundle of papyrus stems of red granite, and their crowns represent papyrus stems. The middle compartment was dedicated to the sacred boat of the god Amun-Ra, the western to the sacred boat of his wife, the goddess Mut, and the eastern to the sacred boat of the son of the god Khonsu, the moon god.

Karnak temple:

It was built by King Tuthmosis III in the west, and it is the smallest of all ten edifices, and it is considered a compass, as it is a northern granite column engraved on its top with a lotus flower, which was growing in the Lower Egypt, and the other and the south opposite it is engraved with the papyrus plant, which was growing in Upper Egypt.

have your lunch on the board. then you will be offered to go to <u>Karnak temple sound and light show</u>, then have your dinner and get a comfy nice sleep.

Day 2: continue Luxor attractions.

the valley of kings:

In the valley of a dry river on the west bank of the ancient city of Thebes (modern Luxor), hence the name Valley of the Kings, but this name is not entirely accurate since some members of the royal family other than the kings were buried there, as well as some non-royals, though they were High-ranking. The Valley of the Kings is divided into the eastern and western valleys.

Hatshepsut temple:

The monastery was built by Queen Hatshepsut to perform rituals that would benefit her in the other world. The name Deir al-Bahari is a modern Arabic name given to this area in the seventh century AD after the Copts used this temple as their monastery. The temple consists of three ascending terraces, connected by ramps for ascent and descent.

Colosi of Memnon:

The statue of Memnon is located on the western bank of Thebes, which is known today as Luxor. Luxor, one of the most important tourist attractions, includes many Pharaonic monuments that are linked to the civilization of the ancient Egyptians thousands of years ago.

End your day with an overnight on the comfortable board.

Day 3: sail to Edfu and Kom Ombo.

The Temple of Edfu or the Temple of Horus is located 123 km north of Aswan, in the city of Edfu. It is one of the most beautiful Egyptian temples.

As archaeologist Ibrahim Suleiman says, it is the important rich discoveries that were found in the city of Kom Ombo, which included the discovery of the oldest pottery-making workshop of the ancient state, dating back to the period of the Egyptian Fourth Dynasty (2613-2494), the period of the builders of the pyramids

Aswan High Dam:

It is a rubble dam on the Nile River in the city of Aswan in southern Egypt. Its length at the summit is 3830 meters, of which 520 meters are between the two banks of the Nile and the rest extends in the form of two wings on both sides of the river. The height of the dam is 111 meters above the level of the bottom of the Nile River, and its width at the top is 40 meters.

Philae temple:

Philae Temple This temple dedicated to the goddess Isis, which was flooded by the waters of the Nile, was divided and reassembled in a new location on the island of Agilika, about 500 m from its original place on the island of Philae.
