Day 1: Embarkation in Aswan

When you arrive in Egypt, a tour guide from [Cairo Top Tours](#) will be waiting for you at the Aswan Airport or the train station with a signboard that displays your name.

You will be transported in a private, nonsmoking, air-conditioned car to the pier where your Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise begins. This wonderful journey along the Nile River will fulfil all of your dreams.

Following boarding and check-in procedures, you will unwind in your cabin before enjoying a delicious open-bar lunch on board and beginning your Aswan sightseeing as follows:

Aside from its attractive appearance, the [High Dam](#) is regarded as the most important project in Egypt's modern history since it protected the country from the Nile River's recurrent floods.

The incomplete obelisk

Continue your [Aswan day tour](#) by being driven to the well-known Granite Quarries, where the ancient Egyptians mined the stones they used to construct the enormous pyramids of Egypt and the enormous temples of the new kingdom. Then, explore [the Unfinished Obelisk](#), one of the examples of how they cut enormous stones and used them in memorial structures, as we see on Egypt tours.

Finally,

Isis Temple:

Take the speedboat to the amazing [Temple of Philae](#), which was dedicated to the goddess Isis and constructed in the Greco-Roman architectural style. The temple is regarded as one of the locations where the tale of Osiris and Seth took place.

Enjoy a beautiful meal on board the cruise ship following your nighttime Aswan excursions, and then take in the entertainment and the unique Nubian folklore show.

Lunch, dinner, and a welcome beverage are all included.

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

You will continue one of the most amazing Day Tours in Egypt, the Tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu, after finishing your breakfast onboard your Egypt Nile River Cruise. The boat will head to the [Kom Ombo Temple](#) as it travels north. We will proceed to the Ptolemaic Temple, a version of Horus that was revered in this area. Everyone will have enough time to visit the temple before your boat departs for Edfu and your delectable buffet lunch is provided.

Upon arrival in [Edfu Temple](#), you will visit the ancient Horus Temple by horse carriage, then the boat will sail to Esna, enjoy your afternoon tea during the sailing. In the evening, another high-grade dinner will be served on board. Entertainment will be a very extraordinary Egyptian Galabeya Party, and you will spend the night aboard your Nile Cruise in Esna after getting back from your [tour to Edfu](#).

Day 3: Luxor Sightseeing Tours

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast while the boat makes its way towards Luxor, then get ready for the West Bank of Luxor Tours, which many people see as the city's top attraction.

Here, many New Kingdom kings and pharaohs, including Ramses the Great, Tutmosis, and the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen, were laid to rest. Tutankhamen's tomb was discovered completely intact in the year 1922, making it one of the most successful

The beautiful [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), one of Luxor's most well-known sites, will be your next stop. Before having another lunch on the ship, you will be taken to view [the Colossi of Memnon](#), which were constructed for King Amenhotep III.

The [Luxor Temple](#) will be seen after the impressively well-preserved [Karnak Temples](#) as part of our ongoing Luxor sightseeing trips. After the incredible East and West Bank day trip, savour a hearty meal and enjoy one more night on the cruise ship.
