Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

The tour guide from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will be waiting to welcome you when you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> with a signboard carrying your name. He will provide comfortable, air-conditioned transportation to get you to your Giza lodging. Prior to arriving, double-check all pick-up times on the itinerary for your <u>Egypt Classic Tours</u> from Cairo to Alexandria trip so that our representative can assist you with a speedy check-in.

Overnight in Cairo

Day 2: Pyramids Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, your English-speaking tour guide will meet you in the hotel to begin your tour of <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you will see the Great Pyramid of King Cheops and the Middle Pyramid of his son Chephren, two of the world's oldest wonders that are still standing today. You will also see the Great Sphinx and the Valley Temple of King Chephren in addition to the pyramid of King Mycerinus.

then you can travel to <u>Memphis</u>, the first Egyptian dynasty capital, in around 35 minutes. You are welcome to look at the treasures and artifacts from that time, when King Menes joined the two nations there 5000 years ago.

Visit <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, one of the most important and ancient archaeological sites in the world, where you can see a number of Mastaba tombs for notable historical characters, such as royalty, nobles, kings, and queens, as well as the ancestors of the <u>Egyptian pharaohs</u>. There are 11 royal pyramids in the Saqqara Necropolis. You will see <u>the Step Pyramid</u>, built for King Djoser by famed architect Imhotep. The first pyramid is this one. We'll take you back to your Giza hotel for the evening once you've completed your exciting <u>Cairo day tours</u>.

Before we proceed to Memphis, which served as Egypt's capital during the Old Kingdom and an important metropolis throughout the Middle Kingdom and the New Kingdom, you can unwind and enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant in the village of Saqqara.

We'll take you back to your Giza hotel for the evening once you've completed your exciting city tours.

Day 3: Alexandria sightseeing tour

Prepare to start your <u>Alexandria day tours</u> after breakfast with your knowledgeable English-speaking Egyptologist guide. All the way from Cairo to Alexandria, we'll convey you in comfort. Along the approximately 2.5-hour journey, there will be breaks along the way.

You will ultimately reach Alexandria, the second-largest city in Egypt and the most magnificent gem of the Mediterranean. Alexandria was established by Alexander the Great, who also ruled Egypt at the time, in 332 B.C. The famous Pompey's Pillar, which was constructed in 297 BC to mark the Roman emperor Diocletian's victory over an uprising in Alexandria, will be the starting point of your sightseeing tour. Diocletian controlled Rome and consolidated power in Egypt between 284 and 305 BC. The Kom El Shokkafa

<u>Catacombs</u> will be the next destination on your itinerary. Having been found around the beginning of the 20th century, they are acknowledged as one of the largest Roman burial sites.

See the original scientific research center's historical location. <u>Alexandrian Bibliotheca</u> was once the largest library in the world. It was built by Ptolemy I at the beginning of the third century BC, and it is located in the city bearing its name, overlooking the Mediterranean.

You must eat seafood if you visit Alexandria. Enjoy your delicious, freshly made lunch.

A van will then transport you back to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 4: Egyptian Museum and Cairo Tour

Prepare to start your <u>Egypt luxury tours</u> after consuming breakfast at the hotel. The <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, one of the most popular museums in the world, has two floors and is home to a sizable collection of Egyptian artefacts. The royal wealth of the golden king Tutankhamun, which is on exhibit separately, is the most remarkable of these artefacts.

See the <u>Saladin Citadel</u>, which was formerly the centre of Egypt's government. You will like exploring Islamic Cairo, which has countless mosques, spires that reach the sky, and stunning, colourful domes that are some hundreds of years old and others that are even older than a thousand. As soon as you arrive, you will go to the <u>Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque</u>, which is claimed to be the only example of Ottoman architecture in Egypt.

Our tour of <u>Coptic Cairo</u> includes a trip at <u>the Hanging Church</u> of the Blessed Virgin Mary, commonly known as Al Mualaka or the hanging church because it was built above the fortress's towers.

Our <u>Egypt day tours</u> also include a visit to the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which was allegedly built where baby Moses' basket was found. The holy family resided here for three months, getting their water from the vault above the synagogue.

Before continuing our tours of Islamic Cairo to the <u>Khan El Khalili</u> market, which is situated in the heart of Cairo's Islamic Middle Ages, we will pause for a delicious lunch. At this area, one can view the mediaeval Cairo walls and gates in addition to the tunnels from the 10th century.

Once you return to Cairo, our agent will take you to your hotel for the night.

Day 5: The White Desert and Bahariya Oasis Overnight from Cairo

Your private tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo at around 7:00 am and bring you to the Bahariya Oasis, which is roughly 360 kilometres to the east of Cairo.

Your Bahariya Oasis and the White Desert are there when you arrive. Lunch in the Bahariya Oasis will be a leisurely start to your overnight adventure in Cairo. We will also visit the Golden Mummies Museum, the Alexander the Great Temple Ruins, and the nobles' tombs at Bahariya Oasis, which are important burial sites dating to the 26th dynasty of Egyptian history and include the tomb of Bannantiu in the Western Desert of

Egypt. You'll depart for the White Desert to tour the <u>Valley of El Haize</u> south of the oasis after a sumptuous lunch at an eatery designed to resemble an oasis. During this break, you can take a quick dip in the warm spring. In the Black desert, where the mountains have slowly been eaten away by natural processes to cover the desert with a coating of black rocky dust, one can travel from the hamlet, a paradise in the heart of the desert. Take a stop to enjoy the shapes of the lovely Crystal Mountain and the spectacular <u>Valley of Agabat</u> as you travel between the Bahariya and Farafra oasis, adjacent to the Crystal Mountain and the White Desert.

We will enjoy camping in the White Desert, where there is a great chance to see an amazing sunset, while your local guides prepare your lunch.

Take in the stunning stars while you're sleeping at the camp.

Day 6: White Desert Back to Bahariya Oasis

You will enjoy an organic local breakfast in the White Desert as part of your Cairo Excursions today while you take in the stunning surroundings. When you continue your day tours from Cairo, you will come across the magnificent white limestone stones that gave the white desert its name. Then, you'll be taken to Cairo over the Black Desert. In Bahariya Oasis, we take a pause to take in the beautiful sand dunes, salt lake, and fruit orchards. The two-day journey from Cairo to the White Desert and the Bahariya Oasis will come to an end. We have around four hours to travel back to the hotel in Cairo.

Day 7: The end of your Egypt tours packages from Cairo

Enjoy your final breakfast while touring Egypt. A tour guide from one of Egypt's top tours will pick you up after you check out and drive you to Cairo International Airport for your final departure.
