Day1: Arrival to Nairobi

Hello! Our representative will meet you at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, assist with your overnight transfer to the Sarova Stanley Hotel, and offer congratulations.

Day2: A Trip to Lake Nakuru National Park

The Kenya honeymoon package takes you to Lake Nakuru, one of the most famous lakes in the Great Rift Valley and home to millions of flamingos, after breakfast. The Sarova Lion Hill Lodge offers an expansive panorama of the lake's pink shoreline and serves lunch. The camp is located inside Lake Nakuru National Park in the Rift Valley Province and is surrounded by native flora and fauna. The afternoon is spent on safari in Kenya's largest rhino sanctuary, where chances of seeing black and white rhinos are almost certain. There are also 450 species of birds, Colobus monkeys, lions, Rothschild's giraffes, and plains game.

Day3: An experience at Maasai Mara Game Reserve

The trip brings you to Kenya's most well-known wildlife reserve, Maasai Mara. Get there early for a lunchtime game watching drive in the afternoon. After spending one more day seeing wildlife and eating all you want, spend the night at your camp. The reserve is a well-liked spot for filmmaking and is home to a variety of species, including the big five. A sight to behold is the yearly migration of millions of wildebeests, zebras, and gazelles from the Serengeti plains across the Mara river and Tanzanian border to the Maasai Mara grazing pastures starting in late June. The reserve is home to around 402 different species of birds. A distinctive tented safari experience is provided by Mara Sarova Camp, which has 75 opulent tents with permanent floors, lush gardens, and a private WC, shower, hot and cold running water, and electricity.

Day 4: Continue exploring Maasai Mara National Reserve

Spend the entire day in the reserve taking use of the camp's amenities and game viewing opportunities.

Day5: Moving from Maasai Mara to Diani

This is the last day of your wilderness adventure. After eating breakfast at the camp, you will check out and be driven to the runway in Nairobi to catch your flight to Ukunda. Take a transfer to your accommodation when you arrive in Diani. A five-star boutique hotel with stunning Swahili architecture, Neptune Palm Beach is situated in lush tropical gardens on a magnificent beachfront in Diani Beach, South Coast. There are just four rooms each unit out of the sixty rooms in makuti roofed cottages. Unwind in the spacious swimming pool with fresh water. You may enjoy both local and foreign cuisine at our main restaurant. Those who enjoy seafood can reserve a seat at the à la carte Mnazi restaurant. The resort is roughly 45 kilometres from Mombasa and 40 kilometres south from Moi International Airport. The nearby Ukunda Airstrip is ca. 8 km away.

Day6: Heading Towards Diani

Spend the entire day at the hotel taking advantage of its amenities.

Day 7: A full day in Diani

Enjoy the whole day at the hotel taking advantage of its attractions.

Day8: From Diani to Nairobi final stop

Enjoy an enjoyable morning at the hotel before transferring to the airfield to catch your flight back to Nairobi, then to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport to catch your flight home.
