Day1: Arrival Arusha

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed by our representative and taken to the Mount Meru Hotel located in Arusha Town, where you can unwind after your flight.

Day2: Tarangire National Park exploration trip

After a delicious breakfast, established up for Tanzania's greatest safari. Visit Tarangire National Park in the morning for a safari to see the enormous termite colonies and the enormous baobab trees. There is a particularly wide variety of prey and hunters in this park, which is home to elephants. Take a drive to end the day and spend the night at Manyara Serena Lodge.

Day3: A visit Lake Manyara National Park

Before leaving Tarangire for Lake Manyara National Park, enjoy a delectable breakfast. Where you will be able to see the Ngorongoro Crater as you travel by. Travel across the Serengeti and stop to take in the wandering and native wildlife of the park. Take in the different vegetation zones around the lake, which include species like wildebeest, cheetah, zebra, lion, giraffe, impala, topi, and leopard that are frequently seen in the Serengeti National Park.

Day4: Explore Serengeti National Park

Following an excellent breakfast, leave for the Serengeti and begin Tanzania's greatest safari, taking in an endlessly scenic drive. Due to its size, you will be able to explore more of the Serengeti than you did in the past. Keep an eye out for cheetahs that may want to get up close and personal for pictures.

Day5: A Trip to Serengeti National Park

On the fifth day, you will spend the entire day watching wildlife. Before returning for another picnic lunch, you will have the opportunity to speak with some of the Maasai herdsman. Your guide will keep you on edge as he points out every detail of the surroundings with a specific goal of helping you spot the Big Five.

Day6: An Exploration trip to Ngorongoro National Park

Travel straight to Ngorongoro and take a full-day game drive down the crater. It is the world's largest intact caldera and well-known for the diversity of wildlife it supports, including flocks of flamingos that swarm Soda Lake. Viewing lions, hyenas, wildebeest, zebras, black rhinoceroses, and numerous species of small antelopes takes place on the crater floor for the whole day. Take advantage of the opportunity to look for the Big Five once more after lunch.

Day7: Saying Goodbyes from Arusha

After all the excitement you must be exhausted, enjoy a relaxing breakfast before leaving for Arusha to take your flight back home.
