Enjoy a visit to the Abu Raed Heritage Museum, the first historical landmark in AlUla to be registered with the Saudi Commission for Tourism and National Heritage in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. With a diverse selection of artifacts from different eras, this museum tells the story of the AlUla region and focuses on local history. Scales of fishing and farming equipment are drawn daily, and collectibles are allowed to be displayed. It includes an educational component dedicated to teaching history and all things related to folk games. Explore the desert on a luxury 4x4 safari before relaxing at the desert campsite as the sun sets. Enjoy a breathtaking sunset in AlUla's famous desert and see the stunning rock formations of Elephant Rock.

Then enjoy Elephant Mountain. Shaped by an elephant with its trunk touching the ground, this incredible rock formation is one of AlUla's geomorphological wonders and a well-known landmark.

One of the numerous geological wonders of AlUla is Elephant Rock, often referred to as Jabal AlFil.

After the sun sets, relax in a desert campground after taking a sumptuous 4x4 safari through the desert. Visit Jabal al-Raqssat, a place with a plethora of religious and nonreligious rock inscriptions.
