Day 1 : Arrival to Casablanca - Transfer to Rabat

Day 2 : Rabat Tours Attractions.

After a satisfying breakfast at your hotel, you will meet your tour guide to begin exploring the captivating capital city of Morocco, Rabat. Founded as a fortress by Abd Al-Mu'min of the Almohad dynasty, Rabat's history unfolds as you visit its notable landmarks.

During the guided tour, you will have the opportunity to visit the magnificent Royal Palace, where you can marvel at its majestic design and impressive architecture. Additionally, you will be able to admire the charming blue and white houses and enjoy the breathtaking views at the picturesque Kasbah Oudaya fortress.

After the guided tour, you will have some free time to wander through the lively souks and bazaars in Rabat's old medina. Here, you will find an array of merchandise, including traditional and modern shoes, Moroccan-style bags, and authentic Berber jewelry.

To immerse yourself in Moroccan hospitality, you will visit the "Café Maure" situated on the banks of the Bouregrag River. Indulge in a cup of refreshing Moroccan mint tea accompanied by delicious Moroccan treats such as Kaab Ghazal.

After bidding farewell to Rabat, you will hit the road and head towards Chefchaouen, known for its stunning blue-painted streets and buildings.

Day 3 : Chefchaouen

After breakfast, your English-speaking driver will meet you to start your guided tour of [Chefchaouen](#). This charming city, known as Morocco's "Blue Pearl," is truly captivating. The blue color of the houses, a tradition with roots in Jewish culture, symbolizes the sky and creates a serene and peaceful atmosphere throughout the city.

Your tour will take you to the Kasbah Ali Ben Rachid and Plaza Uta el-Hammam, where you can experience the beauty and charm of Chefchaouen. The blue tones of the city create a unique and enchanting ambiance, offering a feeling of relaxation and comfort.

Overnight stay: Chefchaouen Meals included: Breakfast, lunch.

Day 4 : Volubilis Tours Attractions.

After enjoying breakfast, you will meet your driver guide who will accompany you on a transfer to Fez. Along the way, we have a must-stop at two remarkable destinations: Volubilis and Meknes.

First, we will visit [Volubilis](#), an archaeological site recognized by UNESCO as a global heritage site. Here, you will have the opportunity to explore the remains of a Roman outpost. Accompanied by a knowledgeable guide, you will stroll through the impressive Triumphal Arches, visit the Capitoline Temple, and admire the captivating Orpheus mosaics that depict stories of Roman life.

Continuing our journey, we will reach the Imperial City of Meknes, a city often overlooked by visitors. Meknes, built by Moulay Ismail, was designed to be the "Versailles of Morocco." Upon arrival, you will meet a local guide who will take you to the renowned Bab El Mansour gate and Lhri, two significant landmarks that showcase the city's rich history and vibrant atmosphere.

After exploring Meknes, we will resume our journey and make our way to Fez.

Day 5: Fez Exploration day

After enjoying breakfast, you'll start your tour of [Fez](#), which was once the capital of the kingdom before 1912 and is rich in history. You'll explore the Medina, a UNESCO World Heritage Site dating back to the 9th century and housing the world's oldest university.

Accompanied by a knowledgeable local guide, you will visit prominent sites such as Bou-Inania and Attarin Medersa, which are stunning examples of traditional Islamic architecture. You will also have the opportunity to witness the traditional tanning process and visit the vibrant Ess-Seffarine Square. Other highlights of the tour include the Moulay Idriss tomb, El-Nejjarine Square, the cabinet makers' souk, and the Hebrew district known as "Mellah."

As part of your Moroccan experience, you will engage in a pottery workshop led by a skilled pottery master. This hands-on activity will allow you to immerse yourself in the local culture and craftsmanship.

Following the morning's exploration, you will enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant. Afterward, you have the option to either return to your hotel or venture out to explore the narrow alleyways of the old town at your own pace.

Interesting fact: Every October, Fez hosts one of the largest and most renowned Sufi festivals, attracting performers from around the world.
