Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), our Cairo Top Tours representative will greet you with a signboard displaying your name. You'll be escorted in a private, air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel in Giza.

Once at the hotel, our representative will assist with a smooth check-in and review the itinerary for your [Egypt Luxury Tours](#) from Cairo to Alexandria, ensuring you are informed of all pick-up times.

Enjoy welcome drinks and settle in for the night in Cairo.

Overnight: Cairo Meals: Welcome Drinks

Day 2: Pyramids Sightseeing Tour

Start your day with a breakfast at your hotel. Meet your certified tour guide and on an exciting tour of the Giza Pyramids.

Marvel at the [Great Pyramid of Cheops](#), an Old Kingdom wonder built 4500 years ago; explore the Pyramid of Chephren, built by Cheops' son, and visit its accompanying [Sphinx](#), the largest in Egypt; See the Pyramid of Mycerinus, the smallest royal pyramid in Giza, with an optional camel ride for stunning photos; Discover the Valley Temple, one of Egypt's oldest temples, where King Chephren's mummy was prepared for the afterlife; Visit the open-air museum in [Memphis](#) City, Egypt's oldest capital, and explore Saqqara's Step Pyramid of King Djoser, the oldest stone building in the world; the pyramid of Teti, inscribed with hieroglyphs; and a richly adorned Mastaba tomb featuring daily life scenes.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Saqqara before returning to your hotel in Giza for the night.

Overnight: Cairo Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Egyptian Museum and Cairo Tour

Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel before continuing your Egypt Classic Tours. Your licensed tour guide will lead you to [the Egyptian Museum](#), renowned for its extensive collection of Egyptian antiques spread across two floors, including the famous treasures of the golden pharaoh Tutankhamun.

Next, visit the Citadel of Saladin, once the heart of the Egyptian government for centuries. Here, explore the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, a unique example of Ottoman architecture in Egypt. Enjoy the sights of Islamic Cairo, with its many historic mosques, sky-piercing towers, and colorful domes, some of which are over a thousand years old.

The Coptic Cairo tour includes the Roman fortress of Babylon and [the Hanging Church](#) of the Holy Virgin Mary, also known as Al Mualaka or the suspended church, built above the fortress towers. You will also visit the Church of St. Sergius, built over the crypt where the Holy Family stayed for three months, and the spring from which they drew water. Continue to [the Ben Ezra Synagogue](#), traditionally believed to be where baby Moses was found.

After a delicious lunch, explore the [Islamic Cairo](#) trips further at [Khan El Khalili bazaar](#) in the heart of medieval Cairo, with its ancient walls, gates, and streets dating back to the 10th century. Conclude the day with a return to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 4: Alexandria Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, meet your English-speaking Egyptologist guide for a day tour of Alexandria. Travel in air-conditioned comfort from Cairo to Alexandria, a trip of about 2.5 hours with a break along the way.

Arrive in Alexandria, known as the pearl of the Mediterranean and the second capital of Egypt, founded by Alexander the Great. Begin your tour at Pompey's Pillar, erected to honor the Roman Emperor Diocletian. Next, visit the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, one of the largest Roman burial sites.

Continue to the seaside to explore [the Citadel of Qaitbay](#), built on the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria, strategically positioned at the end of a narrow land strip extending into the Eastern Port. Visit [the Bibliotheca Alexandrina](#), a modern revival of the ancient Library of Alexandria, facing the Mediterranean Sea.

No visit to Alexandria is complete without a seafood meal, so enjoy a lunch made from the freshest ingredients before returning to your hotel in Cairo.
