Itinerary

Day1: Hi From Istanbul

Meet our agent at the airport in Istanbul after you arrive. After your transfer, spend the night in Istanbul's hotel.

Day2: Discover Istanbul

One of the biggest churches in the world and a stunning architectural marvel, the Hagia Sophia, is visited during the full-day tour of Istanbul. Scattered throughout the city's historic center, the Topkapi Palace is an organic monumental complex that served as the residence of the Sultans from 1478 until 1856. Another striking example of architectural magnificence is the Blue Mosque, which is well-known for its six towering minarets and terraced domes. The Roman Hippodrome, where circuses and chariot races have taken place for over a millennium, is a must-see in the afternoon. After spending some free time at the Grand Bazaar, a covered market, the day comes to a close. After an overnight stay in Istanbul, the tour ends with a return to the hotel.

Day3: Explore Bosphorus

following your hotel-provided breakfast. The Egyptian Bazaar also called the Spice Bazaar, was built in the seventeenth century and is located in the old Eminönü neighbourhood of Istanbul. In the morning, we begin by taking a tour of the bazaar. We continue our routine of taking the Bosphorus boat tour, which circles the Sea of Marmara around the European and Asian sides of the city. During this cruise tour, you will be able to see landmarks like Dolmabahce Palace, Çiragan, and the fortress of Rumeli Hisar? The Beylerbeyi Palace, built of white marble by Sultan Abdulaziz in the 19th century, is the next stop on the journey. It was used as a guest house for celebrities from other countries.

Day4: Travelling from Istanbul to Ankara (By bus 450 Km)

We will Pick you up from your hotel(city center) between 12:00 and 13:00 Our coach leaves Istanbul and travels across the intercontinental bridge to Ankara. And arrival in the nation's capital. After dinner, spend the night in Ankara at the hotel.

Day5: Discover Ankara, Salt Lake, and Cappadocia

First, Take your Hotel breakfast. Then See the Ataturk Mausoleum, honoring the leader of the Turkish Republic, and the Museum of Anatolian Cultures, featuring shows featuring objects from the Neolithic, Hittite, Phrygian, and Palaeolithic times, in the nation's capital. Trip departure (290 km) towards Cappadocia. See one of the Underground Cities created by Christian communities as a means of self-defense along the route. Horses, common areas, conference rooms, and small family rooms are all preserved in the subterranean city. Arrival in the region of Cappadocia. Overnight and dinner in Cappadocia.

Day6: Cappadocia Trip

Take the hotel breakfast. A full day spent exploring this amazing area, which includes the world's only fairy chimneys, the Goreme Valley with its cave churches and paintings from the tenth and eleventh centuries, a visit to the troglodyte village of Uçhisar, a scenic drive through Avcilar, the Derbent Valley with its unique natural rock formations, and time to visit artisan workshops making items like carpets and the onyx stones surrounded by silver jewelry. In Cappadocia for dinner and the night.

Day7: Moving from Cappadocia to Pamukkale (By bus 610 Km)

Day8: Tour between Pamukkale, Ephesus, and Izmir (200 km)

Take a Hotel breakfast. Then Take the Selçuk-Efeso exit. Arrival and tour the Artemis-focused city of Ephesus, an archaeological site. The greatest theatre of antiquity, the Odeon, the Hadrian Temple, the House of Love, the Celsus Library, the Agora, and Marble Street. A visit to the House of the Virgin, which is thought to be the Mother of Jesus' final residence. Visit a center for the production of leather, then head to Izmir, the third-largest city in Turkey, which is about 85 km away. Izmir for dinner and the night.

Day9: Tour between Izmir, Pergamon, Troy, and Çanakkale

First, Have your Hotel breakfast. Then Head towards Bergama, the present Pergamon (110 km). Arrive and take a tour of the Asclepion ruins, which housed a therapeutic center and served as the most significant hospital in all of Asia Minor. Moving to Troy (about 190 km away). See the well-known historical archaeological site that echoes the poetic name of Homer's Iliad saga. Moving to Çanakkale (about 25 kilometers). In Çanakkale, dinner and overnight stay.

Day10: Exploring tour between Çanakkale, Gallipoli, Anzac Cove, and Istanbul

Firstly, Have your breakfast. We'll take a car ferry across the Strait of Dardanelles to get to the Gallipoli Peninsula. The WWI Battlefields of Gallipoli, which include Brighton Beach, Beach Cemetery, ANZAC Cove, Ariburnu Cemetery, ANZAC Commemorative Site, Respect to Mehmetcik Statue, Lone Pine Australian Memorial, Johnston's Jolly, Turkish and Allied trenches and tunnels, 57. Regiment Turkish Memorial, The Nek, and Chunuk Bair New Zealand Memorial represent some of the most moving places we will visit in Turkey. Spend the night in Istanbul.

Day11: Final Departure Istanbul then Arrival Athens
