Day 1: Get to Cairo, Egypt

Upon your arrival at the Cairo International Airport terminal, our Cairo Top Tours representative will be waiting to greet you and provide a private air-conditioned vehicle transfer to the hotel. To guarantee that your trip to Egypt for the New Year's Eve is flawless, he will assist you with the check-in process and make revisions to the 7-day Cairo and Christmas Nile Cruise plan.

Day 2: Egyptian Museum and the Giza Pyramids

After enjoying your first buffet breakfast at the hotel, start your tour of Cairo to see the Pyramids of Giza. See the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, a member of the 4th dynasty, the pyramids of Chephren, his son, and Mycerinus, the owner of the smallest pyramid in the Giza Necropolis. Next, head to the panoramic area to capture special photos of the three pyramids together, and you can even take a camel ride around the Giza Pyramids. Finally, continue your tour of the Giza Pyramids by seeing the Great Sphinx, a mythological animal representing strength and authority, and the Valley Temple, which is part of King Chephren's burial complex. The temple is paved in white marble. After that, we'll begin our tour of the Egyptian Museum, where we'll see numerous amazing artifacts in addition to the riches of the most well-known King Tutankhamen. Vegetarian cuisine is available upon request at the nearby restaurant where lunch will be served. Return to the hotel for the night.

Day 3: Journey to Aswan via Air, Aswan Tours

We will assist you with checking out of the hotel after your daily breakfast and transport you to the Cairo airport in a contemporary air-conditioned car so you can make your domestic aircraft to Aswan. When you arrive at the Aswan airport, meet our representative who will take you to the Nile cruise ship. Check in before lunch, have lunch on the Nile cruise, and begin your Aswan sightseeing tour by seeing the Unfinished Obelisk inside the granite quarries and the High Dam, which shielded Egypt from the yearly Nile floods and the Temple of Philae, which was constructed to honor Goddess Isis, the protagonist of the well-known narrative of Isis and Osiris, one of the most important goddesses of ancient Egypt. After dinner, return to the cruise ship and spend the night in Aswan.

Day 4: Tours of Edfu and Kom Ombo

Starting with breakfast on your Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise, you will visit the temple of Kom Ombo, which is dedicated to the gods Sobek and Horaeris. Next, you will sail towards Edfu to see the Temple of Edfu, which was constructed in honor of the god Horus, the patron of kingship. Finally, you will sail to Esna, where you will have lunch on board and dinner served while you take in the stunning views of the Nile all night long.

Day 5: Tours of Luxor's East and West Banks

After breakfast on the boat, set out on your Luxor Day Tours, starting with the Valley of the Kings, the most significant location for the Luxor West Bank tours. You will see the Temple of Hatshepsut in El-Deir El-Bahary, as well as the enormous statues of King Amenhotep III, which are housed in three tombs within the royal necropolis, which was built for the pharaohs of the new kingdom. The Nile cruise boat will provide lunch and dinner before the Luxor East Bank tours begin.

See the largest sites of Thebes, the Temples of Karnak and Luxor (Luxor these days). The avenue of sphinxes, which connects the two temples, is surrounded by sphinxes with ram's heads on either side. Once more, spend the night on the cruise ship.

Day 6: Return to Cairo by Air; optional tours of Coptic and Islamic Cairo

After breakfast, disembark from the Nile cruise ship and head to the Luxor airport to catch your flight back to Cairo.
