Itinerary

Day 1: Tour to the Giza Pyramids, the Egyptian Museum, and the Old Cairo

On your first day in Cairo, embark on a private day excursion to the Giza Pyramids and Sphinx. Your tour guide will pick you up from your hotel at 8 a.m.

Start your tour at the Great Pyramid of Giza, also known as the Pyramid of Khufu or Cheops, which stands as the oldest and largest pyramid in the Giza pyramid complex. It is the only surviving wonder of the ancient world and a truly awe-inspiring sight.

Next, visit the Pyramid of Khafre (Chefren), the second tallest and largest pyramid at Giza, housing the tomb of Fourth Dynasty pharaoh Khafre.

Continue your exploration with a visit to the Pyramid of Mykerinus before heading to the King Chephren <u>Valley Temple</u>, offering a closer view of <u>the Great Sphinx</u>. Marvel at this legendary guardian with the body of a lion and the head of King Chephren.

You can enjoy a camel ride near the Giza Pyramids for a unique perspective of these ancient wonders. (Optional activity)

Next, you will visit the Egyptian Museum, which is home to an extensive collection of over 250,000 authentic artifacts spanning 5,000 years of history. Explore the dedicated display of Tutankhamun's treasures, including jewelry and gold unearthed during the excavation of his tomb in 1920.

Then we will transfer you to the Saladin Citadel, which was constructed in 1183 AD by Salah El-Din as a defense against Crusader forces. Admire the preserved mosques and museums within this historic complex, including the renowned Mosque of Muhammad Ali Pasha, offering panoramic views of Cairo.

Enjoy lunch at an Egyptian restaurant before continuing your journey to Old Cairo, where you'll visit iconic landmarks such as the Hanging Church, Ben Ezra Synagogue, Church of St. Barbara, and Church of Abu Serga, among others.

Finish your day with a visit to Khan el-Khalili, which is one of the oldest and most captivating markets in the Middle East. Walk and wander through its labyrinthine passages filled with centuries-old commerce and a vibrant atmosphere.

Return to your hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay.

Meals: Lunch

Day 2: Cairo to the Baharyia Oasis and White Desert

A representative will meet you at your hotel in Giza or Cairo to kick off your Bahariya Oasis adventure. The journey to the White Desert and Bahariya Oasis typically takes about four hours. Upon arrival at Bahariya Oasis, your guide will greet you and escort you in a 4x4 Jeep to begin your exploration.

We will transfer you to the Black Desert, which was named for the thin layer of black powder coating its mountains, hills, and dunes. Enjoy lunch at <u>El Haize Oasis</u>, where you'll find peaks adorned with this unique black powder.

Relax and unwind with a soak in a hot spring before lunch, experiencing the natural relaxation induced by the warm waters. Stop at Gebel al-Izzaz, also known as <u>Crystal Mountain</u>, which is renowned for its quartzite crystals that shimmer in the sunlight, earning it the nickname "the Jewel of the Desert."

For a unique and breathtaking stay amidst <u>the white desert</u>, visit <u>the Valley of Agabat</u>, known for its surreal landscape carved by millions of years of water erosion. Afterward, enjoy a sandboarding adventure down Wadi el Agabat in the 4x4 Jeep.

Explore the White Desert National Park, which is a renowned desert destination in Egypt known for its abundance of animal-shaped rock formations, including a sphinx, tents, camels, and mushrooms.

Finish your desert adventure with a transfer back to Cairo.

Day 3: Sightseeing Tour to Alexandria from Cairo

Our day will commence with a meeting with our Egyptologists at 7:00 am at your accommodation in Cairo. We'll embark on a private tour to Alexandria from Cairo, which is situated approximately 220 kilometers northwest. Our first stop will be the Kom El Shoqafa catacombs, which were built in the second century A.D. These catacombs served as burial sites for around 200 years, reflecting the remarkable cultural fusion present in Alexandria's history during that time, blending Egyptian, Greek, and Roman influences.

Continuing our tour, we'll visit Pompey's Pillar, a towering red granite column standing at 25 meters. Though named after the Roman general Pompey, it was likely erected as a memorial for Diocletian the Great.

Next, we'll explore the Qeitbay Citadel, which was constructed by Mamluk Sultan Qeitbay in the 15th century to defend the city against Crusader threats. The citadel was built using the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria, a third-century B.C. structure commissioned by Ptolemy II.

Afterward, we'll enjoy lunch at an Egyptian restaurant before heading to our next destination, <u>The Library of Alexandria</u>. Reopened in October 2002, this stunning structure serves as a symbol of Alexandria's glorious past and a hub for arts, history, philosophy, and science.

Finally, we'll return to your Cairo hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 4: Final Departure

Breakfast will be served at the hotel on the last day of your package. Please be sure to leave the hotel by midnight so that you have time to take one of our optional day trips in Cairo. After you've thoroughly enjoyed your four-day visit to Cairo, your tour leader will transport you to the Cairo airport for your final farewell.
