Itinerary

Day 1: (Monday) Check-in

Your representative will meet you, help you, and transport you to the Steigenberger Omar El Khayam Lake Nasser Cruise for check-in. Lunch will be provided to you as you enjoy the breathtaking views of the Nile from the deck. As you savor your excellent dinner and take in the amazing Nubian display, unwind on the lake cruise boat.

Day 2: (Tuesday) Kalabsha Temple - Sail to Wadi Elsebou

Your Aswan day tour will begin with an open-buffet breakfast in the early morning. After that, you will be taken by our knowledgeable guide to see the magnificent Ptolemaic and Roman buildings. <u>Kalabsha Temple</u> is a Nubian temple that is situated south of Aswan and was built during the 18th dynasty. The Nubian deity Mandoulis was the reason behind its construction.

We will carry on with our Aswan excursions to explore <u>Beit El Wali</u>, a Ramses II-built rock-cut temple honoring Amun-Re, Khnum, Anuket, and Re-Horakhti. During the Christian era, the temple served as a residence for priests and Christian authorities. The temple's architecture is reminiscent of <u>Abu Simble's Temple</u>. After that, eat lunch on board the cruise ship while you continue sailing to Wadi El Sebou.

Day 3: (Wednesday) Wadi El Seboua Temple - Amada temple

We will take you on one of the most fascinating Egypt day tours, which includes a visit to <u>Wadi El Sebou</u>, often known as the Valley of the Lions, after breakfast on the Nile cruise ship. Built in honor of Ramses II, the Wadi El Sebou temple is made up of two buildings. Continue your excursions in Aswan to the well-known <u>Amada Temple</u>, the earliest temple ever found in Nubia. Pharaoh <u>Thutmose III</u> constructed it to honor the god Amon Ra. Undoubtedly, the temple contains some exquisitely maintained characteristics, such as multiple exquisitely carved reliefs that showcase vivid hues. They will serve lunch and dinner, and spend the night close to Amada.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: (Thursday) Kasr Ibrim from Sundeck - Abu Simbel

Sail to Qasr Ibrim and enjoy your breakfast buffet while visiting the impressive monuments that span numerous eras of Egyptian history. Among these are the graves of the Nubian kings who ruled during Thutmosis III's reign. See the location from the outside before going on to Abu Simbel, home of the most magnificent temple in the Middle East and possibly the entire globe.

It is a complex of two temples that <u>Pharaoh Ramses II</u> had carved out of the rock. These monuments honor the monarch and his queen Nefertari, whose triumph at the Battle of Kadesh was commemorated by the enormous rock reliefs outside of them. Following the visits to Abu Simbel, lunch and dinner will be given on board the ship.
