Visit the Valley of the Kings, where numerous notable Pharaohs from the New Kingdom are buried.

You will view the Colossi of Memnon, which are remnants of an ancient Egyptian temple constructed by Amenophis the Third and known by the Greeks as this, and Queen Hatshepsut's Temple of El Deir El Bahari, which is regarded as one of the most famous funeral temples.

As you sail to Esna, the cruise ship will serve lunch, followed by afternoon tea and the Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party. Savor your meal and spend the night at Esna.

# Day 3: Wednesday - Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

After breakfast, you will begin your journey to Edfu and Kom Ombo, two of the biggest temples between Luxor and Aswan. The Edfu tour will begin with a visit to the Temple of Edfu, which is known for its amazing high tension towers.

Battle scenes showing King Ptolemy VIII vanquishing his adversaries in front of the deity Horus can be seen on the temple's walls. There's an open courtyard with columns on three sides that have ornate calligraphy. You'll set sail for Kom Ombo.

After enjoying afternoon tea and lunch on board, you will embark on a journey to <u>Kom Ombo</u>, where you will see the temple and witness the worship of Sobek, a god with a human body and a crocodile head. Following that, you will travel to Aswan on your Nile River cruise through Egypt.

Take your delicious dinner on board and spend the night in Aswan.
