- Mineral water every day while on your Egypt day trips and during the airport transfer.

#### Itinerary

### Day 1: Arrival, Giza Pyramids and Saqqara Necropolis

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, look for our representative there to arrange your private transportation to the hotel in Giza. You can start by leaving your luggage at <u>the Pyramids of Giza</u>, where you can see the most amazing of Egypt's three pyramids. They were built during the Fourth Dynasty of the Old Kingdom in ancient <u>Egypt</u> and are considered to be one of the best <u>things to do in Cairo</u>. You will have the opportunity to have an optional camel ride in Giza Pyramids for 1 hour.

On our tour of the Giza pyramids, we will next stop at the Valley Temple of King Chephren, where we will see his statue, the Great Sphinx, a lion with a human head that stands for strength and intelligence. Transfer to see the Step Pyramid of King Djoser at Saqqara. This structure shows us the development of pyramid construction. It is the initial pyramid constructed in Egypt and while it is not a 'true pyramid' with smooth sides, like the Giza Pyramids the Bent Pyramid, and the Red Pyramid of Dahshur.

Transfer back to the hotel after having a tasty lunch meal in one of the great restaurants, check-in, and overnight in Cairo.

## Day 2: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El Khalili Bazaar

Discover the famous Egyptian artifacts at the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir Square, where you can see many artifacts from different periods, on a guided tour for almost two hours. You will see the enormous statues of Ramses II, the golden mask, and the funerary collections of King Tutankhamun a. After your delectable breakfast is served at the hotel, you will meet your licensed tour guide to start your amazing Cairo city tour.

Transfer to Old Cairo to begin your <u>Coptic Cairo</u> tour, which will take you to the Hanging Church, which was built over the remains of the Roman fortress of Babylon, the Church of St. Sergius, which is located inside a cave, and the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, one of the Middle East's oldest Jewish temples. Enjoy your delicious lunch and a fascinating trip to a well-known market in <u>Egypt's Islamic Cairo</u>. One of Cairo's top tourist destinations for both foreigners and Egyptians is the bazaar neighborhood. As you take the best Cairo walking tours, sip a tea-mint in a neighborhood cafe, or simply wander the area, you can see the magnificent Islamic structures. It also houses many Egyptian craftsmen and workshops that produce traditional crafts and mementos.

Back to the hotel after your excursions in Cairo are done, overnight in the Cairo hotel.
