Day 1: Embarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours

Greetings from Luxor. In order to get you to your opulent MS Nile Ruby Nile Cruise in time for lunch, our representative will meet you at the Luxor airport or train station. Start your Egypt Day trips to east bank of Luxor tours by visiting the Temple of Luxor, which was built by King Ramses II after Amenhotep III had begun construction on it during the New Kingdom. Continue your journey to the Karnak Temple, which served as the administrative and religious hub of the New Kingdom of ancient Egypt. Inside, you'll see the massive hypostyle hall with a forest of columns, enormous statues, and a sacred lake. Your licensed tour guide will accompany you as you transfer to the cruise ship.

Enjoy your meal and the rest of your night on the boat in Luxor.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours

Your Egyptologist will lead you on one of the most enjoyable Egypt Day Tours in Luxor. Enjoy the West Bank of Luxor tours by visiting the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, which is the burial site of several notable kings of ancient Egypt during the new kingdom. On your second day, begin by enjoying your delicious breakfast on the boat with a great opportunity to enjoy an enchanting hot air balloon ride in Luxor in the morning.

You will then be taken to see the Colossi of Memnon, which were constructed for King Amenhotep III, as well as Queen Hatshepsut's Temple at El Deir El Bahari, which is regarded as one of the most significant funeral temples. Before afternoon tea and the Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party begin, sail to Esna and have your lunch served on board the cruise ship. Have fun during supper and stay the night in Esna.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After enjoying your breakfast on the cruise ship, you will sail to <u>Edfu</u> and begin your second Egypt Day Tours by visiting the Edfu Temple, which was constructed for the worship of <u>God Horus</u>, the son of Osiris and Isis and one of the most powerful and important gods in ancient Egypt. You will then enjoy a quiet lunch while taking in the scenery, and then you will visit the Temple shared by two gods, Sobek and Haroeris, in Edfu. After that, you'll sail toward Aswan while taking in an oriental music performance.

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise

You will begin your Aswan day excursions after enjoying a delicious breakfast on board the Nile Cruise before visiting the <u>High Dam</u>, which was built between Aswan and Sudan to the south of Aswan and is considered to be the most important construction project in Egypt's modern history. In order to witness the greatest <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> that was built under the period of the fabled Queen Hatshepsut, ruler of Egypt during the new kingdom, your professional tour guide will then lead you to visit the area of the granite quarries.

Finally, we will take you by motorboat to the <u>Philae Temple</u>, where we will conclude our Aswan excursions. This temple was built for the worship of <u>Goddess Isis</u>, who was the legendary God Osiris's wife, and was the god of the underworld. It was relocated to Agilika Island during a campaign that took place in the 1960s of the 20th century to prevent the temple from being submerged by the water of the Nile.
