Additionally, you can wander among the pillars of the Karnak Temple and the Luxor Temple, which are dedicated to the god Amun Ra, and stroll along the Avenue of the Sphinxes.

Day 1: Embarkation - Aswan day Tour

The local agent of Cairo Top Tours provides you with many [Egypt day trips](#) in Aswan and in the whole of Egypt. He will greet you in the early morning and drive you in a private air-conditioned vehicle to your Nile Cruise boat. In a short while, we'll be checking in on our cruise.

After that, you will travel with our knowledgeable tour guide to the Aswan [High Dam](#), which the late President [Gamal Abdel Nasser](#) constructed in 1960 to save the Nile water and later generate electricity. The [Philae Temple](#), which was constructed in the third century BC during the Greco-Roman era, will be your next stop after sailing toward the banks of the Nile. From there, we will board a speedboat and travel to Agilika Island.

The [Unfinished Obelisk](#), which was uncovered in a granite quarry in the southern part of Aswan, will be our last stop on this amazing day tour. We will return to our Nile Cruise to spend the night after the tour.

Meals: lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Enjoy your breakfast on board your Nile Cruise. The Temple of Sobek & Haroeris, which was constructed during the Ptolemaic period and dedicated to two gods: the regional crocodile [god Sobek](#) and the fabled eagle god Haroeris, will be your next stop when our Mövenpick MS Darakum Nile Cruise docks in [Kom Ombo temple](#). We'll then head back to our boat to rest and refuel after that. Later, we'll go to [Edfu's](#) Temple of Horus, which is the Nile Valley's best-preserved ancient Egyptian temple. Then we'll head back to our boat to spend the night.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3: Luxor West Bank tour

You will be able to enjoy an optional hot-air balloon ride above Luxor. You can also choose one of our [Luxor West Bank Tours](#) to explore this magnificent city. Before exploring the [Valley of the Kings](#), which is one of Egypt's richest and most intriguing ancient tombs, have a sumptuous lunch. The kings of the New Kingdom were interred here. The Temple of Deir El Bahari, which was constructed during the 18th dynasty during the rule of [Queen Hatshepsut](#), who is one of Egypt's finest kings, will be the second stop on the tour. The [Colossi of Memnon](#), the only surviving remnants of Amenhotep III's enormous burial temple, will be the destination of our last excursion. We'll return to our boat for the evening after that.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 4: Check Out - Luxor East Bank

After breakfast, check out your Nile cruise. Our next stop will be the East Bank of Luxor, where we'll visit two stunning temple complexes. Our first destination will be the over-thousand-year-old [Karnak Temple Complex](#). The vast majority of the exquisite artifacts came from the [New Kingdom](#), especially the enormous, breathtaking columns of the hypostyle hall, which were built by [Ramses II](#), the finest builder in ancient Egypt.

After that, we'll see the [Luxor Temple](#), which Ramses II, [Queen Hatshepsut](#), and numerous other Pharaohs built for many years in the 14th century BC. After the trip, we will transport you to your hotel in Luxor.
