Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival day - Aswan Tour

Our tour guide will meet you when you arrive in Aswan and take you to your MS Semiramis II Nile Cruise to start your Egypt day trips with a lunch meal on board. The Aswan High Dam will be your next stop. President Gamal Abdel Nasser built this dam in 1960 to save Egypt from the Nile flood and to generate power and electricity. The colossal Temple of Philae, which was constructed in the Graeco-Roman era and dedicated to the goddess Isis, will thereafter be reached after sailing across the Nile. Last but not least, you will visit The Unfinished Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut, which is a red granite structure erected in honor of Amun Ra.

You'll eventually return to your ship, and you'll have some free time at night to explore Aswan on your own.

Included meals are lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Breakfast will be served on your Nile Cruise. Following that, you will go with our tour guide to one of Egypt's most stunning temples, the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, which was built in honor of the <u>gods Sobek</u> and Haroeris. You will then return to your cruise where you can have lunch and enjoy the Nile's scenery. You will ride a chariot in the afternoon to visit <u>Edfu</u>'s Temple of Horus. You will then go back to your ship where you may unwind and eat dinner. You will watch the onboard Show of Egyptian Folklore at night.

Day 3: Luxor West Bank Tour

Before beginning your tour in Thebes and visiting the west bank of Luxor, where you will visit the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, the royal location where our Pharaohs were buried, enjoy your breakfast on the Nile cruise. You will then go to the enormous <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> temple at Deir El Bahari. This temple was built entirely inside a mountain by the master architect Sennmout on three elevated terraces, this temple is regarded as one of the most beautiful structures ever constructed in ancient Egypt. You will eventually go to the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which was built by King Amenhotep III. You will then go back to your room to unwind and eat lunch on the deck. Enjoy your time and have a delicious dinner tonight.

Day 4: Final Disembarkation

After breakfast, you will visit the East Bank of Luxor, stopping at the grandest and largest Temples-the <u>Karnak Temples</u>, which are thought to be the largest complex construction in the entire world. Then, you will head to the Luxor International Airport, and return to your home.
