Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation - Luxor Tour

Our Cairo Top excursions agent will meet you at the Luxor airport, train station, or hotel to begin your <u>Egypt day trips</u> onboard the Royal Esadora. Transfer to the Luxor Temple, which was established during the <u>New Kingdom</u> It was linked to the Karnak temple by an avenue flanked by sphinxes. It was primarily constructed by two pharaohs, <u>Amenhotep III</u> (who built the inner portion) and Ramses II (who completed the temple). The outside half of the temple was erected by Ramses II, whereas the inner part of the temple was built by Amenhotep III.

Following that, you will go to the <u>Karnak Temple</u> Ancient Egypt, particularly under the New Kingdom, was the most powerful religious center. The primary temple was dedicated to the worship of the <u>God Amun Ra</u>, although as in other Egyptian temples, other deities were also revered. Transfer to the cruise ship in a private air-conditioned tourist car accompanied by our agent. Boarding. Lunch is served on board. Dinner and overnight stay on board.

Day 2: Luxor Attractions

After breakfast on your Nile River cruise, visit the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where the pharaohs were buried in hypogea during the New Kingdom The monarchs of the 18th, 19th, and 20th dynasties, as well as various queens, princes, aristocrats, and even animals, were buried here.

Transfer to the Temple of Hatshepsut, <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>'s (18th Dynasty) unique temple, the most magnificent temple built in the valley and the only one of its sort in Egypt.

Sail to the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which are two massive stone sculptures of Pharaoh Amenhotep III located on the Nile's west bank, near Medinet Habu and south of the great Theban necropolis. Lunch will be served on board. Set sail for Edfu. Dinner and sleeping on board.

Breakfast, lunch, and supper.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Breakfast is served on board. Transfer by horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of Horus, dedicated to Horus, is Egypt's best-preserved temple and was known as Mesen, "the place of the harpoon", "the house of Raa". Set sail for Kom Ombo temple Lunch will be served on board.

Cruise to Edfu temple, a remarkable, perfectly symmetrical structure with two entrances, two hypostyle halls, and two sanctuaries. Indeed, it is dedicated to two gods the falcon god Haroeris (Horus the ancient or the great) on the left side and Sobek, the local crocodile-headed deity, on the right. Set sail for Aswan. Dinner and sleeping on board.

Breakfast, lunch, and supper.

Day 4: Aswan Tour

Breakfast is served on board. Transfer to the Aswan High Dam, which was built in 1960 to safeguard Egypt from the Nile's periodic flooding.

Visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which is well-known for its red granite. The most renowned of these obelisks is dedicated to Queen Hatshepsut, one of Egypt's monarchs and rulers of the 18th Dynasty, wife of <u>King Thutmose II</u>, and the country's first female ruler. Others claim that this obelisk was built by <u>Queen Nefertiti</u>, King Akhnaton's wife.

Sail to the <u>Philae Temple</u>, dedicated to the goddess Isis and located eleven kilometers from Aswan on the island of Philae. Lunch will be served on board.

From Elephantine Island to Aswan, take a felucca tour on the Nile. Dinner and sleeping on board.

Breakfast, lunch, and supper.

Day 5: Disembarkation

Breakfast is served on board. The cruise ship departs. Optional journey to see the majestic <u>Abu Simbel</u> Temples Transfer to (the airport, train station) in Aswan by private air-conditioned tourist car.
