Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation in Aswan - Abu Simbel

After you arrive aboard our representative will take you to start your <u>Egypt day trips</u> in Abu Simbel Temples with your tour guide, for about three and a half hours the <u>Abu Simbel Temples</u> are two magnificent ancient

Egyptian temples located near the southern border of Egypt, The Great Temple of Ramses II is the larger of the two temples and serves as a grand tribute to Ramses II, one of Egypt's most celebrated pharaohs and temple of Queen Nefertari the smaller but equally impressive temple adjacent to the Temple of Ramses II is dedicated to Queen Nefertari, one of Ramses II's principal wives.

Finally, sail to Aswan.

Meals: Welcome drink, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 2: Aswan tour - Kasr Ibrim Citadel

The tour to Kasr Ibrim is given from the ship deck because entry to the site is not authorized. Continue your exploration of Amada's temples, It dates from the 18th Dynasty. Kings Thutmose III (c. 1479-1425 BC) and Amenhotep II (c. 1427-1400 BC) erected the temple's core, as did King Thutmose IV. The tomb of Derr and Pinout is a type of rock-cut tomb. It consists of an antechamber followed by a niche with the remnants of three damaged statues.

Afternoon cruise to Wadi El Seboua to explore the temples of Wadi El Seboua, Dakka, and Meharakka.

Dinner and sleeping on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 3: Wadi El Seboua

Continue sailing to Aswan and have a great breakfast on board. When you pass the Tropic of Cancer, you will be served a beverage before returning to your cruise to eat your lunch on board. You will visit the Kalabsha temple in the afternoon. This magnificent and astonishingly well-preserved edifice is Lower Nubia's greatest free-standing temple. It was constructed during the time of Augustus, the first Roman Emperor (30 BC-14 AD).

Beit El Wali another of Ramesses II's Nubian monuments dedicated mostly to <u>Amun</u> and other gods, is carved from the sandstone mountainside and perhaps unique as the smallest of its type. And the Kertassi Kiosk. A Roman Relic Saved From Destruction When the Aswan <u>High Dam</u> was erected, it created <u>Lake Nasser</u>, the world's largest man-made lake.

Dinner is followed by an overnight stay on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Day 4: Disembarkation

This is the final day of your four-day Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor. It will be time to disembark from the Egypt Nile cruise after breakfast. Depending on your preference, your Cairo Top Tours guide will transport you to <u>Aswan Airport</u> or the railway station.
