Day 2: Luxor East Bank tour

The <u>Luxor Temple</u> is one of the best-preserved ancient monuments, with a massive quantity of construction, enormous pylons, statuary, and relief carvings all intact, making it one of the most stunning views not just in Luxor, but throughout Egypt.

When you visit the <u>Karnak temple</u> in Luxor, you are visiting the heart of the ancient Egyptian <u>New Kingdom</u>, since this vast temple complex was the hub of ancient Egyptian religion.

Day 3: Luxor West bank tour

After breakfast, you will begin your <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u> by exploring the Valley of the Kings, a great necropolis where generations of Pharaohs and Nobles were buried in crypts dug into the cliffs. You will also see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which are two huge statues of King Amenhotep III. Then, you'll go to "ElDier ElBahari," which was built by Queen Hatshepsut, the second female monarch of ancient Egypt and one of the most powerful rulers of the time.
