## **Day 1: Embarkation - Aswan Tours**

After being met at the Luxor International Airport by our tour guide, we will transport you to the Egypt Nile River Cruise embarkation procedures before lunch is served on board. You will meet your Egyptologist tour guide and embark on your Aswan Day Tours to the High Dam of Egypt, which was built to both create the

necessary power and protect the nation from catastrophic floods. Continue your Aswan Excursions to learn about the Isis and Osiris narrative and to see the Temple of Philae, which was erected in Isis' honor as the Goddess of Love and Magic and Osiris' wife in ancient Egyptian mythology.

As you return to the cruise ship traveling down the Nile River, tea time will begin on the upper deck and the Captain will serve a welcome cocktail. Your delectable supper buffet will then be served on board, and a local Nubian band will perform an intriguing Nubian Show to keep you entertained. after which, you'll spend the night in Aswan.

## Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

After enjoying the excursions from the day before in Aswan, have breakfast on board the cruise ship, and then your Egypt Nile River Cruises departs for Kom Ombo. When you arrive in the town, you will be joined by our knowledgeable guide to enjoy your amazing Kom Ombo and Edfu tour. You will get off the boat to explore the temple shared by the gods Sobek and Haeroris in Kom Ombo temple, and the boat will then depart for Edfu while your lunch is being served.

Visit the Edfu Temple in the afternoon, which is devoted to the deity Horus and is where he annually encountered his lovely bride, the <u>goddess Hathor</u>. Because it was buried beneath more than 12 meters of desert sand for so long, it is essentially unchanged. Your dinner will be served on the Nile cruise ship while you travel to Esna, where you will spend the night.

### **Day 3: Luxor West Bank Tours**

On the Sonesta St. George Nile cruise, breakfast is served while you sail to Luxor in the early morning. Start your Luxor day trips with the impressive Luxor West Bank Tours, and visit the Valley of the Kings in Luxor, where 62 kings and rulers of ancient Egypt's new kingdom rest in peace. The valley was a sacred place and the artisans and laborers who helped build it used to live in the nearby village of Deir Al-Madina. Then, continue your Luxor excursions to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at El-Deir El Bahari, a building constructed for the female king who followed Thutmose I, and the Colossi of Memnon, two enormous sculptures of Amenhotep III that now remain where a magnificent temple once stood for him, are examples of this. A belly dancing show will take place at night to round off an action-packed day of fun and adventure. Lunch will be served on the boat and afternoon tea will be served prior to supper.

## Day 4: Luxor East Bank Tours - Disembarkation

Start your Luxor East Bank Tours by visiting the <u>Karnak Temple</u>, one of Egypt's largest temples that served as the country's administrative and religious hub when Egypt first reached Mesopotamia, and the temple it is connected to via the Avenue of the Sphinxes. Luxor Amenophis the third <u>Luxor Temple</u> is a must-see on sightseeing tours, after that, disembarkation from your Egypt Nile River Cruise and breakfast on board the Nile cruise ship. you'll be taken to the <u>Luxor International Airport</u> or train station in Luxor for your departure.
