## Day 1: Aswan City Tour

When you arrive in Aswan, a member of our English-speaking staff will meet you and bring you to your magnificent Nile cruise ship in a private A/C van during your all-Egypt day trips. You will start out with a lunch meal on board.

Following lunch, you will be driven to The High Dam, which Egyptian president <u>Gamal Abdel Nasser</u> built in 1960 to keep Egypt safe from the Nile flood. The Temple of Philae, which was built during the Graeco-Roman era and was devoted to the <u>goddess Isis</u>, is where you'll love spending the remainder of your time after that while you enjoy sailing on the Nile on a motor boat. You will finally be guided to see The <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, This belonged to the god Amun Ra and was made of red granite. You'll return to your ship once your tour is over. Spend the evening in Aswan at your leisure.

If your arrival time in <u>Luxor</u> is so early, we will begin the trip immediately. This is because the cruise checkin time is at that time, and we don't want our guests to waste time waiting in the lobby.

Included meals are lunch and dinner.

## Day 2: Kom Ombo - Edfu

There will be breakfast provided on your ship. Your Egyptologist tour guide will then take you to one of Egypt's most beautiful temples, the Kom Ombo Temple, where the two gods Sobek and Haroeris were once worshipped. Return to your ship and eat lunch while seeing the great river Nile's distinctive scenery on the sun deck. Enjoy a chariot ride in the afternoon to Edfu Temple of Horus, which is regarded as one of Egypt's best-preserved temples. You'll be taken back to your ship after your tour is over. You can unwind throughout the afternoon aboard your ship.

On board, dinner will be provided.

Staff on board will run the Egyptian Folkloric Show party at night.

Included meals include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

### Day 3: Luxor West Bank

On the Nile cruise, breakfast. Then you'll begin your enchanted tour of Thebes, the sacred region, by seeing the west bank of Luxor and the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, which is thought to be the royal cemetery of the Theban kings and rulers of ancient Egypt and the location where our Pharaohs were interred. You will next go to Deir El Bahari to see the Temple of <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>. Because it was entirely carved into the mountain, this temple is regarded as one of the most beautiful specimens of ancient Egyptian architecture. You will see the Colossi of Memnon, which belonged to <u>king Amenhotep III</u>, at the conclusion of the journey. You will then head back to your ship to eat lunch.

Afternoon, free at leisure. Dinner and overnight on the cruise.

## Day 4: Check Out - Luxor East Bank

After breakfast, check out. After that, you can take pleasure in your tour of Luxor's East Bank, which includes the magnificent <u>Karnak Temple</u> Complex, which is thought to be the largest complex building in the world, occupying an area of 100 acres.

Finish your wonderful journey with the Temple of Luxor, which was started by a ruler of the 12th dynasty and finished by Ramses II. After your day tour is over, you will be driven in a private A/C van to where you are staying in Luxor.
