Day 1: Check-in - High Dam - Philae Temple

Start your trip by checking in to your accommodation.

Visit [the High Dam](#), which is located in Aswan. It is a modern engineering marvel built across the Nile River, providing hydroelectric power and irrigation to the region.

Explore the [Philae Temple](#), also known as the Temple of Isis. It is situated on an island and was relocated to its current location after the construction of the High Dam to preserve it from flooding.

Day 2: Kom Ombo Temple - Sailing to Edfu

After your breakfast let's visit the Kom Ombo Temple, which is located in [Kom Ombo temple](#). It is a unique temple dedicated to two gods, Sobek (the crocodile god) and Horus (the falcon-headed god). After launch, embark on a sailing journey along the Nile River towards Edfu.

Day 3: Edfu Temple - Karnak Temple - Luxor Temple

Take your breakfast and go to explore the [Edfu](#) Temple, dedicated to the falcon god Horus. It is one of the best-preserved ancient Egyptian temples and offers a fascinating insight into ancient Egyptian religious practices.

Then travel to Luxor, known as the world's largest open-air museum, and visit the [Karnak Temple in Luxor](#) complex. It is a vast temple complex dedicated to the god Amun-Ra, featuring impressive columns, obelisks, and statues.

End the day by visiting the Luxor Temple, located in the heart of Luxor city. It is another magnificent temple dedicated to the Theban triad of gods, Amun, Mut, and Khonsu.

Day 4: Valley of the Kings - Hatshepsut Temple - Colossi of Memnon

Begin your day by exploring the Valley of the Kings, situated on the west bank of the Nile River in Luxor.

This ancient burial ground is home to the tombs of pharaohs from the New Kingdom period, including

[Tutankhamun's tomb](#). Then visit the Hatshepsut Temple, also known as Deir el-Bahari. It is a stunning mortuary temple dedicated to Queen Hatshepsut, one of the few female pharaohs in ancient Egypt.

Finally, see the Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues representing Amenhotep III. These statues are all that remains of the once-splendid mortuary temple.
