Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation/ Luxor East Bank Tours

In Kom Ombo, you'll explore the unique double temple dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon-headed god Horus. These temples provide fascinating insights into ancient Egyptian mythology and religious practices.

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

On the fourth day, your Nile Cruise will reach Aswan, where you'll have the opportunity to explore various attractions.
