## Day 1 : Luxor East Bank tour

Our representative will meet you at the Luxor airport or train station and bring you in a private airconditioned vehicle to embark on your Movenpick MS Hamees Nile Cruise Luxor to Aswan, where your holiday will begin with a visit to the Luxor East bank.

The <u>Luxor Temple</u> is one of the best-preserved ancient monuments, with a massive quantity of construction, enormous pylons, statuary, and relief carvings all intact, making it one of the most stunning views not just in Luxor, but throughout Egypt.

When you visit the <u>Karnak temple</u> in Luxor, you are visiting the heart of the ancient Egyptian <u>New Kingdom</u>, since this vast temple complex was the hub of ancient Egyptian religion.

### Day 2: Luxor West Bank tour

After breakfast, you will begin your <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u> by exploring the Valley of the Kings, a great necropolis where generations of Pharaohs and Nobles were buried in crypts dug into the cliffs. You will also see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which are two huge statues of <u>King Amenhotep III</u> Then you'll go to "ElDier ElBahari," which was erected by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, the second female monarch of ancient Egypt and one of the most formidable kings.

## Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After breakfast, you will tour the Temple of <u>Edfu</u>, which is one of the most well-preserved temples in Egyptian history. Take a horse carriage to the famed Temple of Edfu, which is devoted to the <u>god Horus</u> and is one of Egypt's largest temples.

Then, while sailing to Kom Ombo, you will have lunch and explore the massive Kom Ombo Temple, which is dedicated to the two deities that your experienced guide will explain. Enjoy the celebration and spend the night on the Nile boat.

#### Day 4: Aswan tour

In the afternoon, you will begin your Aswan day tours by visiting the Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, the Greco-Roman temple that was built for the worship of one of the most remarkable deities in ancient Egyptian religion, the famous goddess Isis, and exploring the magnificent Philae Temple.

where you may see the greatest obelisk in Egyptian history, the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, built by Queen Hatshepsut but never completed.

## Day 5: Disembarkation

After breakfast, you can get an optional tour of <u>Abu Simbel Temples</u> that great temple dedicated to the protective gods of ancient Egypt. Amun of Thebes (Luxor now), <u>Ptah</u> of Memphis (Egypt's capital during the old kingdom), and Ra.
