Day 1: Embarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours

After that, you will transfer to your Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship in a private, air-conditioned car that is not smoking. Continue to unwind in your cabin before enjoying lunch on board.

Visit the enormous Karnak Temple, which according to ancient Egyptian mythology served as Amun-Re's throne as the Lord of Gods, to kick off your Egypt day tours. then, your day trips to Luxor After viewing the enormous Luxor Temple, which was uncharacteristically constructed so near to the Nile River, continue on to an oriental belly dance performance by a local professional dancer for two hours. Following your Egypt Nile River Cruise's Luxor excursions, the ship will sail to Edfu where a delectable lunch buffet will be provided. Later in the afternoon, tea will be served on the sun deck, and the captain will host a welcome cocktail party. Enjoy your meal on board while admiring the breathtaking Nile scenery, then spend the night at Esna.

Day 3: Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

Enjoy a delicious breakfast on the third day of your MS Amwaj Living Stone Egypt Nile River Cruise before we begin the informative Kom Ombo and Edfu trip with a visit to the Edfu Temple, one of the most impressive structures from ancient Egypt that dates to the Ptolemaic Period. We'll set sail for Kom Ombo temple to see the temple there.

Due to the fact that there are two parallel temples, the construction is remarkable. Horus was worshipped in the northern portion, while <u>Sobek</u>, the crocodile god, was honored in the southern portion. The two gods were worshipped at this temple, which was constructed. Before visiting and departing for Aswan, lunch will be served on board the ship and afternoon tea. The cruise will serve dinner before docking at Aswan for the night.

Day 4: Aswan Tour

You will enjoy Aswan day tours to visit the <u>High Dam</u>, which is located to the south of Aswan on the route to the airport, after enjoying your excellent breakfast aboard the Nile Cruise in Aswan. The High Dam is the most significant accomplishment in Egypt's modern history. The largest <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which was likely built by the renowned Queen Hatshepsut who ruled Egypt during the New Kingdom, is then located in the Granite Quarries, which you will explore with the assistance of your private tour guide.

The Temple of Philae was built during the Ptolemaic era and was moved to the <u>Agilica island</u> during a salvage campaign that took place in the 1960s of the previous century to save the temple from being flooded by the Nile River water. The temple was built to honor the goddess of Magic, Isis, who was the mother of the falcon God Horus, and it will be our last stop on your Aswan excursions. Enjoy your afternoon tea and onboard meal.

On board the Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship, you will have a sumptuous meal while taking in the Nubian Folkloric Show performed by Aswan-based native Nubian artists.
