Itinerary

Day 1: Check-in upon arrival at Cairo International Airport

Upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you, holding a signboard with your name on it. They will escort you to your hotel in an exclusive air-conditioned vehicle for check-in. Rest assured that our team has reviewed your Cairo Short Break in 4 Days itinerary to ensure that all <u>Egypt tour Packages</u> are scheduled according to the allowed time frame. Enjoy a welcome drink upon arrival at your hotel.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids and Saqqara Tour with Quad Biking

Start your day with breakfast at your hotel before being picked up by your expert Egyptologist guide and transferred to the <u>Giza Necropolis</u>. Marvel at the only remaining wonder of the ancient world, the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, which was built 4500 years ago to serve as an endless home for the half-god king. Take in the full view of the three pyramids, including the pyramids of King Chephren and King Mycerinus, with the queen's pyramids beside the smallest pyramid.

- -Visit the Valley Temple of Chephren, which was created from the bedrock and is believed to be the place where the mummification of the royal body took place as part of the funeral rituals.
- -Next, visit the area known as Saqqara, the necropolis of an earlier period roughly 200 years before the great kings who built the three pyramids in Giza. See the first-ever stone pyramid, built by the genius architect Imhotep for his King Djoser. The Step Pyramid in Saqqara is great evidence of the development of the pyramid-building process, as it is composed of six rectangular steps above each other, with a burial pit underneath by means of 20 meters.
- -You'll also have the chance to enter the pyramid of King Teti, who ruled Egypt during the 6th dynasty, and get fascinated by the tomb of his son-in-law Kagemni. The tomb has random scenes for almost every kind of animal, fish, and bird depicting daily life hunting scenes carved in perfection, in addition to the good preservation of the original colors.
- -After your tours, enjoy an adventurous Quad biking in Giza Pyramids for 1 hour before heading back to your hotel.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum and Coptic Cairo Tour with Dinner Cruise

Start your day with breakfast at your hotel before being picked up by your expert Egyptologist guide and transferred to <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>. Marvel at the artifacts and treasures of ancient Egyptian civilization, including the collection of King Tutankhamun's tomb.

-esume to the area of Old Cairo to start your Coptic Cairo tour at the Roman Fortress of Babylon. Explore the area's ancient churches and synagogues, including the Hanging Church, one of the oldest churches in Cairo, and Ben Ezra Synagogue, believed to have been built on the site where baby Moses was found by Pharaoh's daughter.

After your tours, enjoy a dinner cruise on the Nile and take in the breathtaking views of Cairo's skyline at night. Enjoy the entertainment of belly dancing and a Tanura dance show, showcasing traditional Egyptian dances.
