On your Cairo day tour to the Giza Pyramids, Dahshur, and Memphis with our tour guide, you'll get the opportunity to learn more about the history of the great pyramid builders after eating your breakfast.

You can now start your day trips from Cairo with a tour of the Giza Pyramids.

A stunning illustration of the craftsmanship and commitment of ancient builders is the Great Pyramid of King Cheops

Visit the Great Sphinx in Giza, a statue of a lion with a human head that is said to have been created by King Chephren. Enter the Valley Temple, where the king's mummification was performed as part of the burial procedure. Resuming your excursions of Cairo, head to Mit Rahina, the location of the former city of Memphis, where you can view the open-air museum housing the second-largest sphinx made of alabaster, and the enormous statue of King Ramses II, one of the most influential rulers of the new country.

The Red Pyramid and the Bent Pyramid are two of the four pyramids that were built for King Snefru, the 4th dynasty's founder and the father of King Cheops. We will then travel to the Dahshur archaeological site to see them. One of the most distinctive pyramids in Egypt is the Bent Pyramid, which still has a significant amount of outer casing material. The reddish tint of the limestone at the Red Pyramid makes it known. It is regarded as the first perfectly shaped pyramid in Egyptian history and was built of blocks.

Before being driven back to your hotel, you'll savor a delectable lunch in a highly regarded restaurant with a view of the Giza pyramids.

Day 3: Fly to Hurghada, Optional Hurghada Bedouin Desert Safari By Jeep
