Itinerary

Day1- Tour To Pyramids Of Giza ,the Egyptian Museum and Old Cairo.

We'll take you on a private day trip to the Giza Pyramids and Sphinx on your first day in Cairo. At 8:00 a.m., our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel.

The Great Pyramid of Giza, the largest and oldest pyramid in the Giza pyramid complex, will be your first stop. It is also known as the Pyramid of Khufu or the Pyramid of Cheops. Of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, it is the oldest and only intact survivor.

The Great Pyramid of Giza, one of the most well-known and impressive ancient buildings in the Giza Pyramid complex, will be your first stop on your tour. The Khufu Pyramid or the Cheops Pyramid is one of the seven wonders of antiquity. This magnificent monument is an amazing sight that is both fascinating and impressive, making it a great place to start your tour of the Giza Complex.

Next, we'll go to the Pyramid of <u>Chephren</u>. The tomb of Fourth-Dynasty pharaoh Khafre (Chefren), who ruled between 2558 and 2532 BC, is located in this pyramid, the second tallest and largest of the three ancient Egyptian pyramids at Giza. We will then proceed to the Pyramid of Mykerinus.

Additionally, we'll stop by the King Chephren Valley Temple. Your view of the Great Sphinx, a legendary guardian that stands atop a large burial complex and has a lion's body and the head of King Chephren on top of it, will be improved as a result. Next, we'll embark on An excursion on a camel near the Giza Pyramids.

You will visit the greatest place The Egyptian Museum, home to a priceless collection of more than 250,000 authentic artefacts dating back more than 5000 years, which will be our next stop. There is also a special exhibit for Tutankhamun, which features a number of artefacts, jewellery pieces, and gold that were found in 1920 during the excavation of his tomb.

In order to defend himself against Crusader forces, <u>Salah al-Din</u> built the Saladin Citadel in 1183 AD. With mosques and museums, including the <u>Mosque of Muhammad Ali Pasha</u>, it is now a historically preserved area. It is well known for having clean air and offering expansive views of Cairo.

Lunch will be served to you in an Egyptian eatery.

Following that, go to Old Cairo to discover some of Cairo's One of the Middle East's oldest and most interesting markets is Khan el-Khalili, which you can visit. You'll wander through the confusing labyrinth of alleys that have long served as Cairo's commercial hub.

Day2- Cairo to the Baharyia Oasis and White Desert

A representative will meet you at your hotel in Giza or Cairo to begin your <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> tour. You'll travel for about four hours to reach the <u>White Desert</u> and Bahariya Oasis, where a safari guide will take you on a 4x4 Jeep adventure.

During the tour, you'll visit the dark desert, named after the black powder that covers the mountains, hills, and dunes. You'll also stop at El Haize Oasis for lunch and relax in a hot spring before visiting Gebel al-Izzaz, also known as Crystal Mountain, which is famous for its quartzite crystals.

For a unique stay in the White Desert, check out the surreal landscape of the Valley of Agabat, where you can also sandboard down Wadi el Agabat by the 4x4 Jeep.

You'll also tour the White Desert National Park, which features animal-themed rock formations like a sphinx, a tent, camels, and mushrooms. Afterward, you'll be transported back to Cairo.

Day3- Cairo to Alexandria

Your private tour of Alexandria from Cairo will begin at 7:00 am when Egyptologists meet you at your accommodation in Cairo. You'll travel about 220 kilometers northwest to Alexandria to start your day trip.

You'll first visit the Kom el Shoqafa catacomb, built in the second century AD to hold the dead for 200 years during Alexandria's history of cultural mingling. Next, you'll see Pompey's Pillar, a red granite column built as a memorial to Diocletian the Great.

The <u>Qeitbay Citadel</u>, built in the 15th century by Mamlouk Sultan Qeitbay to defend against Crusaders, will be your next stop. This Islamic masterpiece was constructed using the ruins of the previous Lighthouse built by Ptolemy II in the third century BC.

After lunch at an Egyptian restaurant, you'll visit the Library of Alexandria, a stunningly beautiful structure that unites the arts, history, philosophy, and science. It's become a place for open conversation, understanding, and discourse.

You'll return to your Cairo hotel for an overnight stay.

Day4- Final Departure

The final day of your Tour includes breakfast at the hotel. To allow yourself enough time to participate in one of our optional day trips in Cairo, please make sure to check out of the hotel by 12:00 PM.
