 - Distance traveled: 69.2 km
 - 1 hour and 37 minutes in time

On arrival to Fayoum, you will begin your day in <u>El Fayoum</u>, by visiting the <u>village of Tunis</u> which takes you through lush green fields and desert landscapes, with a backdrop of the serene <u>Lake Qarun</u> that enclosed sweet lake in the heart of the Western Desert.

Continue your journey at <u>The Valley of the Whales</u>, it is an open-air museum that showcases the evolutionary evidence of the ancient sea mammal's transition to land animals. The site is home to invaluable fossil remains, including petrified sea creature skeletons, shark teeth, and primitive whale bones that date back over 40 million years.

Also, You will have a visit to <u>Magic Lake</u> to see how it changes its colors several times in the day, then go to the mountain of el Mudwara and have the adventure of climbing it. then back to have your overnight in tents and have deep sleep in the camp.
