# Day 1: Tour to Siwa Oasis trip from Cairo

The trip will start with a meeting with your tour guide and travel to Siwa in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle. Siwa is located approximately 600 kilometers northwest of Cairo. You will pass by Marsa Matruoh, which has one of Egypt's most beautiful beaches. The tour will stop at a nearby restaurant for lunch.

Upon reaching Siwa, our team will help you to check in and spend the night there to get ready for the exciting sightseeing tour on the following day.

### Day 2 : Siwa tour

The Siwa tour will begin after breakfast with a visit to the Cleopatra Bath, which is a famous natural water spring where guests can take a dip. Next, the tour will visit the <u>Temple of the Oracle</u> of Amun, which is an important and well-known structure in Siwa and the site where the Great Alexander sought recognition as the King of Egypt. The tour will then proceed to the Mountain of the Dead, where rock-cut tombs from the Greco-Roman era to the 26th Pharaonic dynasty can be founded. You will see the Notable tombs include that of Si-Amun from the third century BC and the tomb of Mesu-Isis, which were belonging to a priest from the 26th dynasty. The guest will spend the night at a hotel in Siwa.

## Day 3 : Continue Siwa tour

After breakfast, you will continue your tour in Siwa with a trip to the Great Sand Sea in Egypt's Western Desert, which is the largest desert on the continent. Guests can enjoy the beauty of the unique landscape and endless sand dunes. The tour will also include sandboarding for a thrilling experience of sliding down the sand dunes. After passing by Dakrour Mountain, the tour will stop at the Bir Wahid hot spring for a relaxing break. The guest will spend the night at your hotel in Siwa.
