Itinerary

Day 1: Tour to El Fayoum from Cairo

Our tour leader will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo and transfer you to Fayuom in a contemporary, air-conditioned vehicle. A trip through the hamlet will help you to have a deep knowledge of Egyptian agricultural life, the area's famed pottery studios and schools, as well as a few businesses that provide excursions on desert safaris to the area's breathtaking landscapes.

Start with the Beautiful <u>Lake Qarun</u>, which spreads for miles down the main road near Tunis Village and is a must-see in Fayoum.

Every time you see a boat, you can be sure that you will be able to take a ride. The tranquil waves will guarantee you a tranquil experience as they softly rock you up and down.

After that, you will be able to go to any of the safari shops sprinkled throughout <u>Tunis Village</u> and request to be taken to Magic Lake. It's just great to visit this magnificent lake, which is hidden behind vast sand dunes and changes color depending on the time of day and year. The off-roading experience is surely exciting; to get there, the tour guide will jam you into a grumbling 44 and drive you 45 minutes into the desert.

They will prepare a nice meal for you when you arrive at the lake, unpack some blankets and Bedouin tea, and then strap you into the <u>sandboard</u> and help you slide down the dune to the dazzling natural beauty. Next, visit Wadi Al Rayan, which is the largest natural oasis in Egypt.

Then we'll take you to your hotel in Fayoum so you can unwind and spend the night.

Day 2: Continue your tour in El Fayoum and Back to Cairo

After breakfast, you will be picked up by our tour guide to go to <u>Wadi El Hitan</u>, which is often known as the "Valley of the Whales," a captivating UNESCO World Heritage site that was originally a lake and is now home to coastal marine species that have existed for millions of years. It is possible to find preserved whale fossils here, providing evidence of the mammal's transition from a terrestrial to a marine animal. It is definitely worthwhile to visit this magnificent location. We'll eat lunch at a nearby restaurant.

Then we will move to the Kom Aushim Museum, which is a great location to get guides for the whole of Fayoum. The Museum was initially built in 1974. Along with artifacts from the Prehistoric through Roman eras, it also includes a painting of Fayoum.

The following station will be one of the largest Greco-Roman settlements in the Fayoum Karanis (The Lord's Town), where originally inhabited in the third century B.C. by mercenaries from the army of Ptolemy the Second. There are two temples in the city.

We'll then take you back to your hotel in Cairo.
