Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

For more knowledge about ancient Egyptian history, visit Saqqara and the Step Pyramid of Djoser with your guide. You'll explore some of the most impressive tombs in Egypt, including the mastaba of Kagemni, one of the most significant tombs from ancient times.

Next, you'll visit Dashur, where you can see the two pyramids built by Pharaoh Sneferu. Witness the Red Pyramid, the first real pyramid in the world, and even have the opportunity to go inside it.
