The second stop on the east bank of the Nile River will be the Luxor temple, which was originally constructed under the reign of Amenhotep I and was later expanded upon by numerous other rulers

throughout history. Our final stop is the <u>Hatshepsut temple</u>, which is known for its intriguing story and impressive construction time of 15 years. After visiting the temple, we will take a break for lunch at a local restaurant in Luxor before heading back to your hotel in a private car.
