Itinerary

Day 1-Arrival to Cairo, Check in.

Your tour guide will be waiting for you at Cairo airport, and they will then transport you to your hotel, the Swiss in the Nile, using a comfortable and air-conditioned vehicle. You can relax and rest at the hotel for the night.
