Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive at Cairo

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet you, holding a signboard with your name on it.

Our representative will provide you with a comfortable, air-conditioned private transfer to your hotel. They will assist you with a swift and straightforward check-in process. Once settled, they will go over your Egyptian travel package itinerary, confirming the pick-up times for each day and discussing any optional tours you might be interested in.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara and Memphis Tour

Begin your day with a delectable breakfast at your Cairo hotel before setting off on your Cairo Day Tour with your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide.

Our first stop is the <u>Giza Pyramid</u>, where you'll marvel at the Great Pyramid of Cheops, one of the seven ancient wonders still largely in existence today. Discover the architectural genius behind the pyramids, standing once as the tallest structure in the world.

Next, visit the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, successors of Khufu and significant rulers of Egypt's fourth dynasty. Don't miss out on the iconic Sphinx, a majestic lion statue with a human head, standing tall for over 45 centuries. Enjoy a panoramic view of all the Giza pyramids together, a perfect time for memorable photos. An optional 15-minute camel ride around the pyramids is available.

Afterward, we'll journey to <u>Saqqara</u>, where you'll visit the Djoser Pyramid, the world's first stone structure, and the pyramid of Teti, known for its awe-inspiring interior. You'll also explore the 4000-year-old Tombs of the Nobles, featuring inscriptions and paintings depicting the daily life of ancient Egyptians.

Following lunch at a local restaurant, we'll head to Memphis, the pharaohs' capital for a millennium and a significant cultural and religious center during ancient Egypt. Visit the open-air museum, known for the alabaster Sphinx and the colossal statue of Ramses II.

Finally, return to your hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay. Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor/ Luxor Excursions

After a hearty breakfast at your hotel, prepare for an early 3:30 am transfer to Cairo International Airport to catch your flight to Luxor. Upon landing, a local representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet and assist you, ushering you into a full day of exploration in Luxor's west bank.

Immerse yourself in ancient history at the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where you'll learn about the evolution of royal funerary practices in the face of tomb robbery. Next, marvel at the imposing <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, statues representing the Pharaoh on a grand scale, seated on the throne of Upper and Lower Egypt.

Our journey continues to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, a marvel of architecture known as Deir El Bahari to the Arabs, designed by one of antiquity's most gifted architects.

Following this, we'll venture to Luxor's East Bank to explore the <u>Karnak Temples</u> complex, revered as the most significant religious site in ancient Egypt.

After checking in late at your hotel and resting, experience the enchanting atmosphere of Luxor Temples at night. The illuminations cast a magical glow on the pillared courtyard and granite statues of Ramses II.

Finally, we'll transfer you back to your hotel for a night's rest in Luxor. Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 4 : Cairo City Tour

Following breakfast, continue your Egypt Classic Tours as our representative escorts you to the airport for your flight back to Cairo. Today's adventure begins at the Egyptian Museum, home to the world's largest collection of Egyptian antiquities, including the intact treasure of the golden pharaoh Tutankhamun.

Next, we visit the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u>, an Islamic-era fortress featuring the stunning Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque. From its lofty location, you can enjoy a panoramic view of Islamic Cairo, adorned with centuries-old mosques, minarets, and domes.

The journey continues to Coptic Cairo, where you'll explore the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and the Hanging Church. This 7th-century structure, dedicated to the Virgin Mary, suspends over the fortress's bastions and served as the residence for Coptic patriarchs in the 11th century. Visit the Church of St Sergius, home to a crypt where the holy family stayed for three months, and Ben Ezra Synagogue, said to be where Moses's basket was found in the Nile.

After lunch, delve into the heart of Islamic Cairo to discover its medieval walls, gates, and centuries-old streets. Conclude your walk with a cup of tea at Fishawy, the oldest café in Khan El Khalili, Cairo's renowned bazaar.

Check into your hotel for a well-deserved night's rest in Cairo. Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 5 : Final Departure
