Day 1 Itinerary: Arrival to Luxor - Luxor East Bank

Day 2 Itinerary: Luxor Tours

After breakfast on the cruise ship, you will leave for your destination. You will eventually continue your Luxor sightseeing excursions in Deir Al-Madina and at the Temple of Madinet Habu, which was constructed by the New Kingdom pharaohs. The Nile cruise ship will sail to the town of Esna, where lunch will be served before afternoon tea and the Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party. Day 3 Itinerary: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples
