Itinerary

Day 1: Aswan City Tour

Your guide in Aswan will pick you up early in the morning and drive you in a private air-conditioned vehicle to your Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship to begin your Aswan day excursions. In a short while, we'll be checking in on our cruise. After that, you'll go with our knowledgeable tour guide to the Aswan High Dam, which was constructed in 1960 by the late Egyptian ruler Gamal Abdel Nasser to store Nile water and generate electricity.

A motorboat will next take us to Agilika Island, where we will explore the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, The incomplete Obelisk <u>Unfinished</u>, which was found close to Aswan.

Day 2: Kom Ombo - Edfu

A renewing breakfast on the ship. Our Nile Cruise ship will then embark on our <u>Kom Ombo</u> and Edfu tour and dock in Kom Ombo. Here, we will visit the Temple of Sobek & Haroeris, which was constructed during the Ptolemaic period and finished during the Roman era and was dedicated to two gods, the local crocodile god Sobek and the fabled eagle god Haroeris.

We'll then head back to our yacht to unwind and rest after that. We'll see the best-preserved ancient Egyptian temple in the Nile Valley, the <u>Edfu Temple of Horus</u>, later. We'll go back to our yacht after that to spend the night.

Day 3: Luxor West Bank

As part of our <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u>, we are delighted to offer you an optional extra: a mesmerizing Hot-Air Balloon ride above Luxor's West Bank. This exhilarating experience will provide you with a unique perspective of the ancient wonders that await you.

Before immersing yourself in the treasures of the West Bank, our tour will begin with a delightful brunch to energize you for the day ahead. Your first stop will be the renowned <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, an archaeological marvel known for its rich and captivating ancient tombs.
