Day 1: Friday - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

At the <u>Aswan Airport</u>, you will be greeted and assisted by one of our agents. You will then board your Egypt Nile River Cruise and enjoy lunch before starting your <u>Aswan day tours</u> with a visit to the Aswan High Dam, whose construction was funded by the Soviet Union in the 1960s in order to protect Egypt from the annual Nile floodwaters.

During the excursions in Aswan, you will also see the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which was constructed to worship Goddess Isis, the Egyptian deity of magic. The temple was constructed in the Greco-Roman style with a view of the Nile River, making it one of the most stunning in all of Egypt.

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

After completing your <u>Egypt Day Tours</u>, prepare to board a ship for Esna and spend the night there before preparing for your excursions to Luxor the following day.

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor Tours

These temples are dedicated to the powerful Theban Triad, consisting of the Sun-God Amun-Re, his consort the Cat-Goddess Mut, and their son Khonsu, the god of the moon.
