Day 02: Luxor West Bank - Sail to Edfu

On your Egypt Nile River cruise, have breakfast. Then our guide will take you to the west bank of Luxor includes the Valley of the Kings, which is thought to be the royal burial ground of Theban kings and rulers of ancient Egypt and the location where our pharaohs were buried. This will be your first stop on your wonderful tour of Thebes, the sacred country. You will next travel to the Queen Hatshepsut temple at Deir El Bahari, Due to the fact that it was completely carved out of the mountain, this temple is regarded as one of the most exceptional specimens of ancient Egyptian architecture. Day 03: Edfu - Kom Ombo - Sail to Aswan
