Day 1: Friday -Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Your 4-day Royal Ruby Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor will depart from the [Aswan airport](#) or train station, where our representative will receive you and transfer you in a luxury air-conditioned car. Before lunch, you will board the boat to begin your Aswan excursions, which will then take you to the Aswan [High Dam](#). You will then continue your Aswan excursions by visiting the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), which is renowned for its red granite and was used to build many famous structures, including the pyramid of Mycerinus and the Valley Temple of King Chephren.

Continue your Aswan sightseeing tour to the [Temple of Philae](#), which honors Goddess Isis, the goddess of sorcery, and moved from Philae Island to Agilika Island as a result of the construction of the High Dam. Transfer back to the cruise ship and take pleasure in your meal and the captain's welcome drink.

Food: Lunch and Dinner

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Before beginning your tour of the [Kom Ombo Temple](#) of Sobek, have your breakfast on board the cruise ship. This remarkable structure is fully symmetrical, and has two entrances, two hypostyle halls, and two shrines.

While traveling to [Edfu](#), the cruise liner served lunch.

After that, transferred to the Horus-dedicated Temple of Edfu. Dinner will be served on board as you cruise near Luxor.

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours

Breakfast in the morning on the elegant Royal Ruby Nile Cruise. After lunch, explore the [Luxor Temple](#), which was constructed during the New Kingdom. It was primarily constructed by two of the greatest pharaohs in ancient Egyptian history, Amenhotep III (who built the inner section) and Ramses II (who finished the temple), and it was connected to the [Karnak Temple](#) by an avenue of sphinxes. Visit the Temple of Karnak, which was ancient Egypt's most significant religious site, notably during the New Kingdom, as you continue your Luxor east bank tours. As with other Egyptian temples, other deities were also present and have been worshiped in addition to the deity Amun, whose devotion was the focus of the principal temple. Dinner and overnight stay on the cruise ship in Luxor

Meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner

Day 4: Monday - Luxor Last Day Tours

Take pleasure in your final breakfast on board the five-star Royal Ruby Nile. After disembarking, you may begin your thrilling [Luxor West Bank tours](#) by going to the [Valley of the Kings](#), where the pharaohs were

interred during the New Kingdom.

The [Colossi of Memnon](#), two enormous colossal statues of King Amenhotep III, are your next stop. They are situated on the west bank of the Nile, close to Medinet Habu and south of the enormous Theban necropolis. The end of our services will be when we transfer them to the airport, railway station, or any other preferred drop-off place inside Luxor.
